

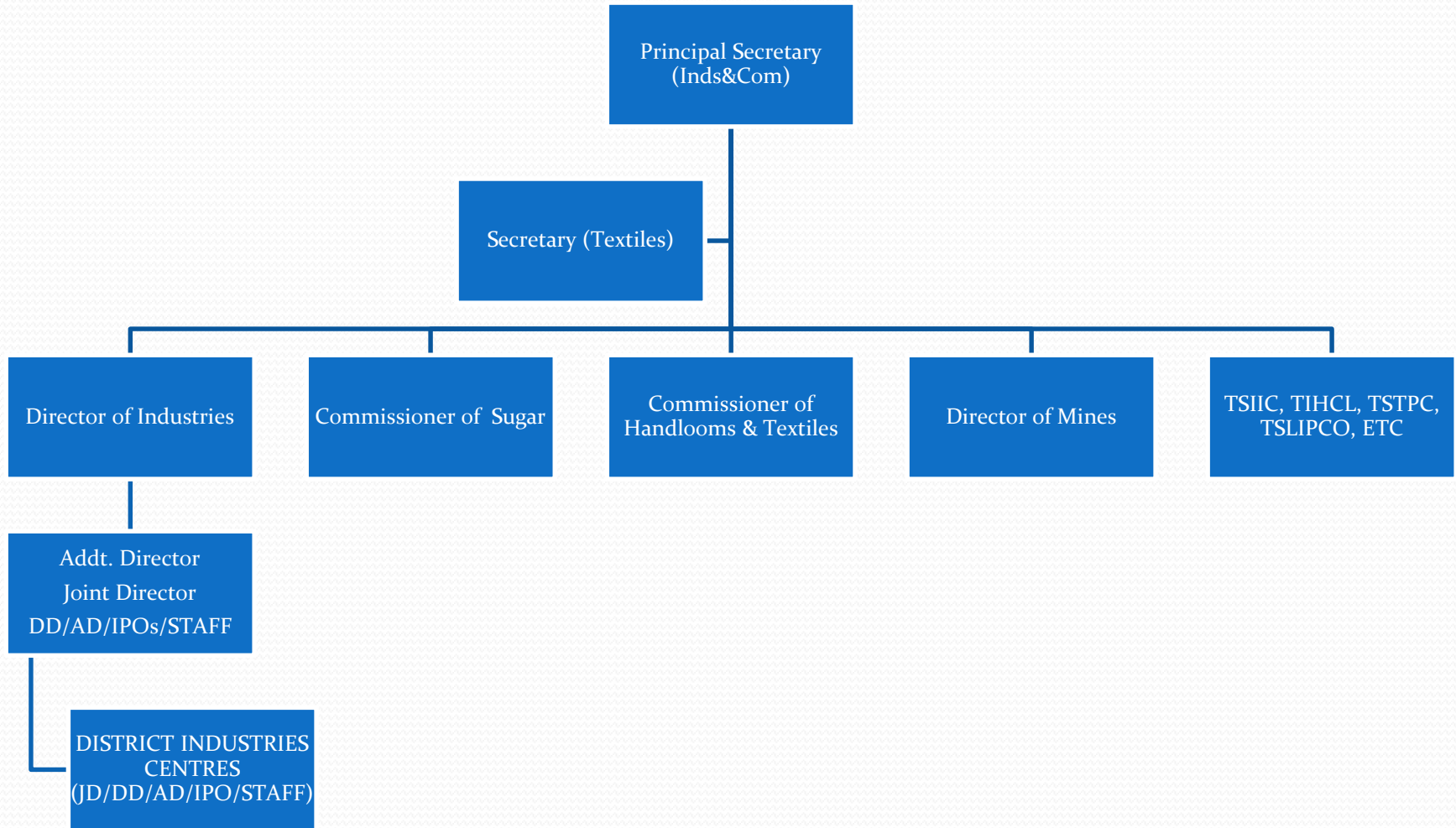

Overview of few

MSMED Act 2006

- An Act to provide for facilitating the promotion and development and enhancing the competitiveness of micro, small and medium enterprises and for matters connected therewith
- Deals with classification, promotion of MSMEs
- Will elaborate on classification and MSEFCs

Udyam Registration

- The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises of Government of India has brought in wef July 1, 2020 a new system of registration for MSMEs in place of Udyog Aadhar Memorandum. This also brought in new classification of MSMEs with both investment and Turnover criteria.

Classification of MSMEs

- **a micro enterprise**, where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed one crore rupees and turnover does not exceed five crore rupees
- **a small enterprise**, where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed ten crore rupees and turnover does not exceed fifty crore rupees
- **a medium enterprise**, where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed fifty crore rupees and turnover does not exceed two hundred and fifty crore rupees

DELAYED PAYMENTS TO MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES - MSEFCs

- Where any supplier supplies any goods or renders any services to any buyer, the buyer shall make payment therefor on or before the date agreed upon between him and the supplier in writing or, where there is no agreement in this behalf, before the appointed day: Provided that in no case the period agreed upon between the supplier and the buyer in writing shall exceed forty-five days from the day of acceptance or the day of deemed acceptance.
- The Supplier can approach MSEFC if the payments are not made within the stipulated time

MSEFCs Status

- More than 4000 applications filed
- Till date 624 orders given and 484 cases mutually settled
- Partnership with International Arbitration Centre wrt Arbitration in high value cases
- Departmental Arbitration Centre is also being set up

Raw Material Support

- Scarce raw material under the Government control like Coal and Alcohol allotted through transparent end to end online system
- Till date 400 applications processed in the system

Marketing Support

- Exemption of EMD / Security Deposit and preference to local manufacturers

Cluster Development

- Nearly 50 clusters are under various stages of Development in the State
- These include Flatted Factory Complexes, New Industrial Estates and upgradation of existing Estates
- The Clusters include Gold Ornament Cluster, Auto Cluster, Textile Cluster, Marketing Hubs, etc.

PMEGP

- **This is a bank linked Government of India scheme for setting up of new self employment projects in both urban and rural areas.**
- Eligibility Criteria
- Any individual, above 18 years of age.
- There will be no income ceiling for assistance for setting up projects under PMEGP.
- For setting up of project costing UPTO Rs.50.00 lakhs in the manufacturing sector and Rs.20.00 in the business / service sector
- Subsidy / Margin money component from 15 to 35%

PMEGP in the State

Total of 2537 units were grounded in the year 2022-23 with a margin money component of 101.94 crore and employment generation of 20296 by

KVIC / DIC / KVIB

PMFME

- GM, DICs have been made Nodal Officers for implementation of PMFME Program in Telangana.
- During the year 2022-23, 1288 applications with a loan component of 6261 lakh have been sanctioned.

ODOP / DLEPC

- One District One Product scheme of Government of India is one such scheme that has the objectives of not only ensuring that one product that has potential in the district is promoted for exports and also making the District an export Hub by facilitation among all the stake holders.
- Government of Telangana in order to take to implement the program has constituted the District Level Export Promotion Committees with District Collector as Chairman, JtDGFT as co-chair and GM, DIC as Convener. Meetings were conducted and products identified in each District based on their potential for exports and strength of the District.
