“Dr. MCR HRD Institute Launches Its Maiden E-Learning Program for Employees, Sponsored by DoPT, Govt. of India”

“DoPT, Govt. of India identified Dr MCR HRD Institute to roll out e-Learning modules for cutting edge functionaries of Govt. of Telanagana”—Sri B P Acharya

Dr. MCR HRD Institute of Telangana launched its first-of-its-kind e-Learning program for cutting-edge level functionaries of Ranga Reddy District. The total duration of training will be for twenty eight hours in which e-Learning will be for twenty hours, covering twelve generic and three domain-specific e-modules, to be completed over a period of next sixty days.

Sri S Niranjan Reddy, Vice Chairman, Telangana State Planning Board called upon extensive use of Information & Communication Technology (ICT), considering the fact that it is being successfully used across the globe for the delivery of all public services. Continuing his address, he stated that e-Training of employees is the need of the hour as they are the bridge between the Government and the people. He said that the Hon’ble Chief Minister of Telangana, who is a great friend of employees, expects them to contribute to the growth trajectory of the State in a big way, rather than confining themselves merely to their limited job description. “Employees should understand the felt needs of people, find enduring solutions to them, and serve with a missionary zeal”, he said and added, with a sense of optimism, that the e-Learning will empower them to play a more constructive role in the dynamic perspective of the State.

Dr. Devesh Chaturvedi, IAS, Joint Secretary, DoPT, Govt. of India said that, in the past, training effort focused mainly on Group A and Group B officers. However, he added, that there is a major shift in the priorities of the Government of India and the training needs of Group C and Group D employees are receiving the attention that they richly deserve. “The selection of six States from across the country, namely, Assam, Haryana, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal, and Telangana to impart e-Training to 82,000 employees during 2017-'18 is a step in this direction”, he said and added that its focus is to bring about a major transformation in the soft skills and attitudes of employees.
