The Tea Factory, Ooty, Tamilnadu

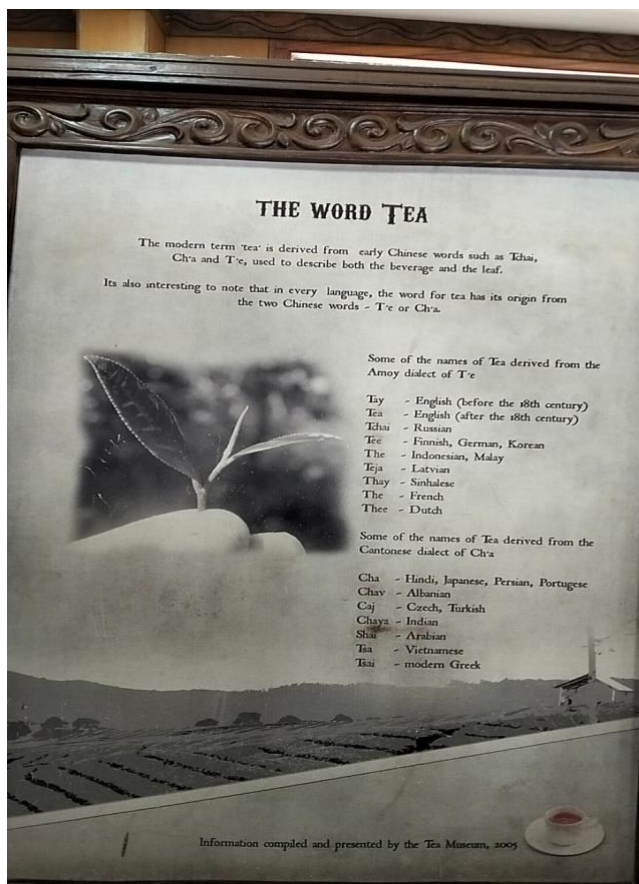
