INQUIRY

- Petty Offences may be disposed off by the Board through summary proceedings.. [Rule13(2)(d)]
- Non Serious Offences (less than 7 yrs imprisonment for adults) the Board shall follow the procedure of trial in summons cases... [Sec 54(1) read with rule 13 (2)(d)]
- Serious offences (punishable with imprisonment of more than 7 yrs for adults) the Board shall follow procedure of trial in summons cases.. [Sec 54(1) read with rule 13 (2)(d)(e)]

CHILDREN' COURT

HENIOUS OFFENCES / SERIOUS OFFENCES

Offences for which the minimum punishment under the IPC or any other law is imprisonment ≥ 7 years.

• Persons above 16 years can now face severe punishments even for offences that are not against the body, such as trading in certain drugs, attempts to commit robbery armed with a weapon, etc. They can also be tried as adults under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and the Indian Penal Code for engaging in consensual sex with persons below the age of 18 years.

ROLE OF PROBATION OFFICER

- 1.District probation officers were redeployed in each district and attached to JJB.
- 2.DPOs are designated as nodal officers for CP BHAVAN
- 3. Submission of Social Investigation Report(SIR) and Assisting JJB while conducting Preliminary Assessment.
- 4.Regular monthly visits were made by DPOs to identify the Juveniles in Central & District Prisons.
- 5. Montly reports of children who were kept under supervision of DPO submitted to JJB, CWC and Courts

DURING HOLIDAYS CHILD PRODUCED BEFORE A SINGLE MEMBER OF THE BOARD

The Police Officer must -

- ☐ the parent or guardian of the juvenile about the apprehension;
- □them about the address of the Board, place, time & date when the parent or guardian should be present before the Board; about the need of surety & bail bond; give copy of police report; ask them to bring proof of juvenility; identity proof (voter ID card, ration card etc)
- □the concerned Probation Officer about such apprehension.. sec13

I N F O R

What information should be collected before producing the juvenile before the JJB?

- Circumstances of apprehension of the juvenile
- Offence alleged to have been committed
- Record information about his social background
- The information may be collected through personal interviews, from the members of the family and locality where they are residing, from the social agencies and other sources. This information shall be recorded in the case diary of the juvenile and forwarded to the Board at production of the CCL [Rule-11 (6),(9),(11) JJRule,2007].

DONT'S

- While in the police station or otherwise the child should not be mentally or physically abused/ assaulted
- The care & protection of the child begins from the PS
- Counseling of the child begins as soon as the child is apprehended and brought to the police station (LPO)
- Police officer shall be in plain clothes and not in uniform while dealing with the juveniles.. Rule 75

The Police Officer after apprehension of the child

NO HANDCUFF



No handcuffs or fetters shall be used while dealing with the juveniles... Rule 76



□ No juvenile shall be charged with or tried for any offence together with an adult. [Sec18] ☐ Principle of non-stigmatizing semantics, decisions and actions to be followed. [Rule 3(VIII)] □ Even if the juvenile ceases to be a child during the pendency of the inquiry the Board shall pass orders as if he is a juvenile[Sec 3] ☐ The inquiry to be completed within a period of 4 months after the first summary inquiry. [Sec 14 (1) read with rule 13(6) and rule15(1)] ☐ In case of a foreign national the Board gives due protection to the child till he/she gets repatriated to the country of his/her origin at the earliest in coordination with the respective Embassy or High Commission.[Rule79(4)(5)(6)]




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




ROLE OF POLICE-I

WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENT

PHILOSOPHIES

USED IN JUVENILE JUSTICE

FOUR MODELS

- >TREATMENT MODEL,
- > JUSTICE MODEL,
- > CRIME MODEL,
- > BALANCED AND RESTORATIVE MODEL

TREATMENT MODEL:

BASED ON THE BELIEF THAT THE BASIC MISSION OF JUVENILE JUSTICE IS TO REHABILITATE YOUTHFUL OFFENDERS.

JUSTICE MODEL:

BOTH JUVENILE AND ADULT OFFENDERS ARE VOLITIONAL AND RESPONSIBLE HUMAN BEINGS AND DESERVE TO BE PUNISHED BY THE LAW. THE PUNISHMENT THEY RECEIVE MUST BE PROPORTIONATE TO THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE OFFENSE.

CRIME CONTROL MODEL: EMPHASIZES PUNISHMENT AS THE REMEDY FOR JUVENILE MISBEHAVIOR. THE CRIME CONTROL MODEL HOLDS THAT THE FIRST PRIORITY OF JUSTICE SHOULD BE TO PROTECT THE LIFE AND PROPERTY OF THE INNOCENT.

BALANCED AND RESTORATIVE JUSTICE MODEL:

MISSION IS TO DEVELOP A COMMUNITY-ORIENTED APPROACH TO THE CONTROL OF OFFENDERS RATHER THAN RELYING SOLELY ON EITHER PUNISHMENT BY CONFINEMENT OR INDIVIDUAL REHABILITATION THROUGH COUNSELING.






»CHILDRENS COURT

As per Section 21 JJ Act, 2015,

- > "No child in conflict with law shall be sentenced to death or life imprisonment without the possibility of release."
- > Social investigation report considered before sentence
- > 16- 18 : JJB (3 YEARS)
- > 16 -18 : CHILDREN COURT : Maximum imprisonment as per the offence

The Positives

- Rehabilitation and Social re-integration of CICL
- Establishment of facilities such as children's homes, observation homes.
- Minimum Mandatory rehabilitation and re-integration services
- 3 MEMBERS OF CWC could declare a child legally free for adoption.
- Greater Penalty for disclosure of identity of child
- Addition to special offences against children use of children for drug peddling, smuggling

The Positives

- 16-18 YEARS
- PRELIMINARY ENQUIRY FOR JUVENILE
- APPEAL TO CHILDREN COURT
- INTER COUNTRY ADOPTION

New Definitions

- 1. Adoption Regulations framed by CARA
- 2. After care financial or other support (but Sec. 46 only mentions financial support)
- 3. Child Welfare Officer attached to Children's Home to carry out directions of CWC/JJB
- 4. Child Welfare Police Officer At police station level. (As per Sec. 107, cannot be below the rank of ASI)
- **5.** Children's Court under CPCR Act, POCSO, Sessions Court having jurisdiction to try offences under JJ
- 6. Child care institution CH, OH, SH, Place of Safety, Open Shelter, Fit Facility recognised for care and protection of children

- > CHILD LINE SERVICES
- > District Child Protection Unit
- > Foster care: Foster family found suitable by DCPU: Group Foster care
- > Inter-country adoption by NRIs, PIOs, Foreigners. OCIs not mentioned.
 - >No objection certificate issued by CARA for inter-country adoption
- > Open Shelter a facility for children registered under Sec. 43. (not specified as a facility for short term or temporary care in the definition)
