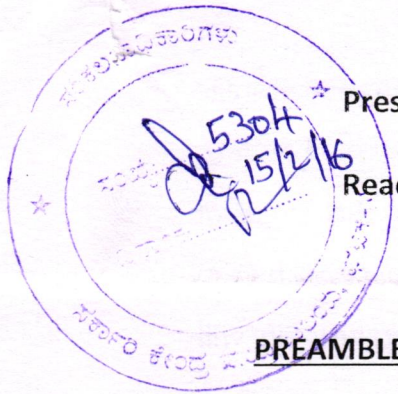

WHEREAS anti-social elements are likely to take advantage of the situation after consumption of liquor indulging in acts of violence and disrupt free, fair and peaceful conduct of ensuing Bye-Election to 158-Hebbal Assembly Constituency

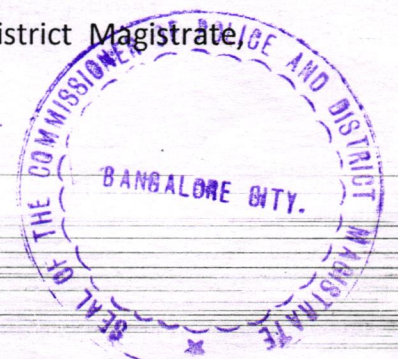
WHEREAS I consider it absolutely necessary to maintain peace in the interest of free fair peaceful and smooth conduct of the polling in Bye-Election to 158-Hebbal Assembly Constituency

WHEREAS the sale, consumption of liquor, wine arrack or any other intoxicants are likely to lead to violence which will affect free, fair, peaceful and smooth conduct of the election and also create Law and Order problem in the said police station limits.

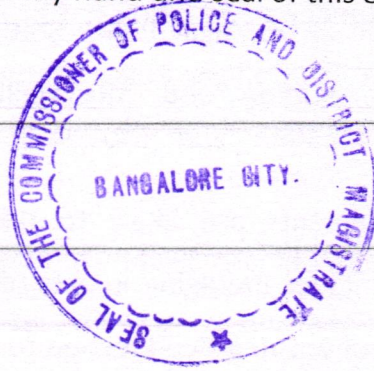

PREAMBLE :

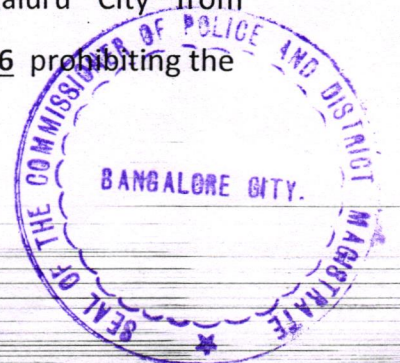

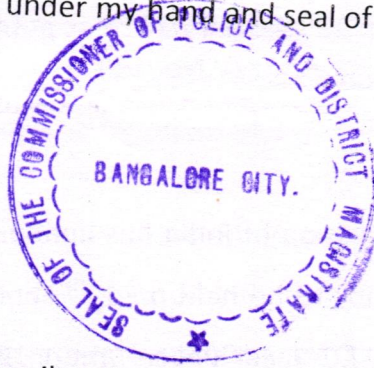

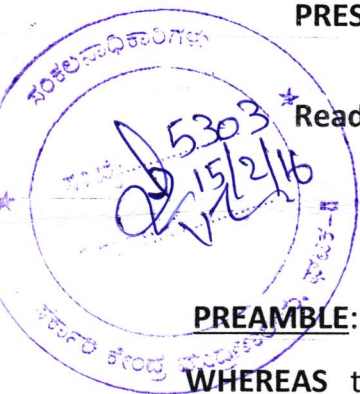

PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS the Election Commission of India has announced Election to Zilla Panchayath and Taluk Panchayath to be held on 13th February 2016. The Model Code of Conduct would be in force till 24th February, 2016 in the limits of Zilla Panchayath and Taluk Panchayath Constituencies.

WHEREAS I consider that it is necessary to prohibit the use/carrying all types of fire arms in the limits of Zilla Panchayath and Taluk Panchayath Constituencies which comes under Bengaluru City Police Commissionerate till the completion of Model Code of Conduct, for the purpose of peaceful, free, fair and smooth conduct of election process, and also absolutely necessary to get the fire arms deposited with the jurisdictional police station, during the period of election.

WHEREAS I am personally satisfied that the enforcement of prohibitory order under section 144 and 144-A of Criminal Procedure Code is necessary for the above said purpose.

ORDER NO.SB/ZP &TP ELN/5(1)/2016, DATED: 03-02-2016

THERE FORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (1) and (3) of Sections 144 and 144-A of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, N.S. Megharikh, IPS., Commissioner of Police and District Magistrate, Bengaluru City do hereby order that all the fire arms of licence holders in the Zilla Panchayath and Taluk Panchayath Constituencies having jurisdiction over the following Police Stations of Bengaluru City

Police Commissionerate should be deposited with the jurisdictional Police Station on or before 03-02-2016 till 24-02-2016. Further, the carrying of arms in any procession or the organising or holding of, or taking part in, any mass drill or mass training with arms in any public place is prohibited in the jurisdiction of the aforesaid police stations till 24-02-2016.

This order shall however not be applicable to the following category-

1. Central and State Government Departments.
2. Public Sector and other Private Sector undertakings (i.e. Banks, Security Agencies etc.) where fire arms licences were issued to the managements for the purpose of the security with strict directions to the management to ensure that these fire arms are to be used for the purpose for which these have been issued.
3. Gazetted Officers of both Central Government and State Government.

Individuals seeking exemption from depositing their fire arms in exceptionally deserving cases, can file their applications giving reasons for seeking exemption before the Deputy Commissioner of Police of their respective jurisdiction on or before 03-02-2016 who will forward it to the Commissioner of Police, Bengaluru city with his remarks before 08-02-2016.
