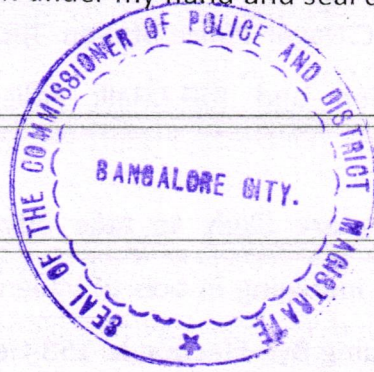

WHEREAS, I consider it absolutely necessary to maintain peace in the interest of free fair peaceful and smooth conduct of the polling in Bangalore City

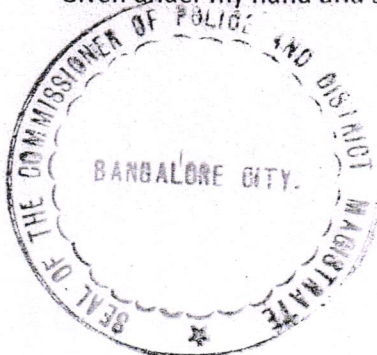

ORDER NO: S.B/L.S/ELN/5(1)/2014, DATED: 14-04-2014

THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Sub-section (1) and (3) of the section 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code. I, Raghavendra Auradkar, ,IPS., Commissioner of Police, Bengaluru city, do hereby promulgate orders in the limits of Bengaluru city from dated **15-04-2014, 05-00 P.M. to 12-00 Midnight of 17/18-04-2014** prohibiting the carrying of any type of the fire arms and deadly weapons, such as cudgels, swords, bludgeons, guns, knives, sticks or lathies or any other articles which are capable of being used for causing physical violence in public places. **But this ban order is exempted for the traditional Karaga religious procession which will be taken out in the night of 15/16-04-2014.**
