**Preamble:**

Whereas, Chief Secretary and Chairman, State Executive Committee, Karnataka State Disaster Management Authority has issued a detailed order and guidelines imposing certain restrictions in Karnataka State, including Bengaluru City, in order to contain spread of Covid-19 pandemic, with effect from 9 pm of 21<sup>st</sup> April to 6 am of 4<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

Whereas, despite rapid increase in number of Covid-19 positive cases in Bengaluru city, it is noticed that in certain public places, people are gathering in a large number without maintaining social distancing, violating Covid-19 protocol, whereby pandemic is spreading very fast, endangering human life and health. This has also caused extreme burden on the health infrastructure of the city and has caused panic and restlessness in the minds of public, which could also adversely impact public peace and order.

Therefore, in order to prevent danger to human life and health and maintain public peace and order, it is considered essential to restrict the number of people, gathering in any public places. **Hence the order:**

**ORDER NO: SB/INT/Prohibitory Order/09/2021, DATED: 21.04.2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred u/s 144(1) Cr.PC of 1973, I, Kamal Pant, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Additional District Magistrate, Bengaluru City, hereby prohibit assembly of more than four (04) persons in public places, except for the purposes which are exempted or where already number of persons have been

specified vide order cited at Reference. Each person in the gathering shall necessarily follow Covid protocols. However, Bus Stands, Railway and Metro Stations, Airports are also exempted from this order.

This order shall be in force till midnight of 4<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

Any violation of the aforesaid instructions shall be liable for prosecution under provisions of section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, Section 188 of IPC and Section 4, 5 and 10 of the Karnataka Epidemic Diseases Act, 2020.

If any one considers to have been adversely affected by this order, he/she can file an appeal to modify or cancellation of this order u/s 144(5) & 144(6) to this office or the Government of Karnataka respectively.


**Preamble:**

In the wake of increasing number of Covid-19 cases in Bengaluru, the order of the Chief Secretary & Chairman, State Executive Committee, Karnataka State Disaster Management Authority vide cited at Sl.No.1, has imposed certain reasonable restrictions for public safety and health. This includes wearing masks, social distancing and proper sanitation and prohibiting public gathering in large numbers. In order to ensure that the above instructions are effectively implemented, it is considered necessary to impose a prohibitory order to enforce the above said regulations. Therefore the below order:

**ORDER NO: SB/INT/Prohibitory Order/06/2021, DATED: 04.04.2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred u/s 144(1) Cr.PC I, Kamal Pant, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Additional District Magistrate, Bengaluru City, hereby prohibit the following activities within the limits of Bengaluru City Commissionerate.

1. Rallies, Dharanas etc. for any purpose by any group or organization.
2. Gatherings/ public functions, group prayers or any type of celebrations in the places of worship. However, individuals are allowed to offer prayers.
3. Operation of Swimming Pools and operation of Gyms with more than 50% capacity, including those located in apartment complexes as per Order cited at Ref(3).

4. No Pubs, Bars, Clubs, Restaurants etc. shall host visitors/ patrons more than 50% seating capacity.
5. No shopping Malls, Markets, Departmental Stores or any other place of public gathering shall function without strict enforcement of Covid Appropriate behavior (CAB) like wearing of masks, physical distancing, provision of hand sanitizer / hand wash. If there is any violation of the aforesaid protocol, such facility/ establishment shall be closed until further orders.

The number of persons permitted for different activities shall be in accordance with the circular cited at Sl.No.2

This prohibitory order will remain in force, in all parts of the Bengaluru City Police Commissionerate until 20.04.2021 midnight. It would be subject to the relevant orders of the State and Central Government, which are in force or would be issued from time to time.

In case, any person is found violating the aforesaid instructions, the defaulting person(s) shall be proceeded against as per the provisions of section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, Section 188 of IPC and Section 4, 5 and 10 of the Karnataka Epidemic Diseases Act, 2020.

If any person feels adversely affected by this order, he/she can file a petition to modify or cancellation of this order u/s 144(5) & 144(6) to this office or the Government of Karnataka respectively.
