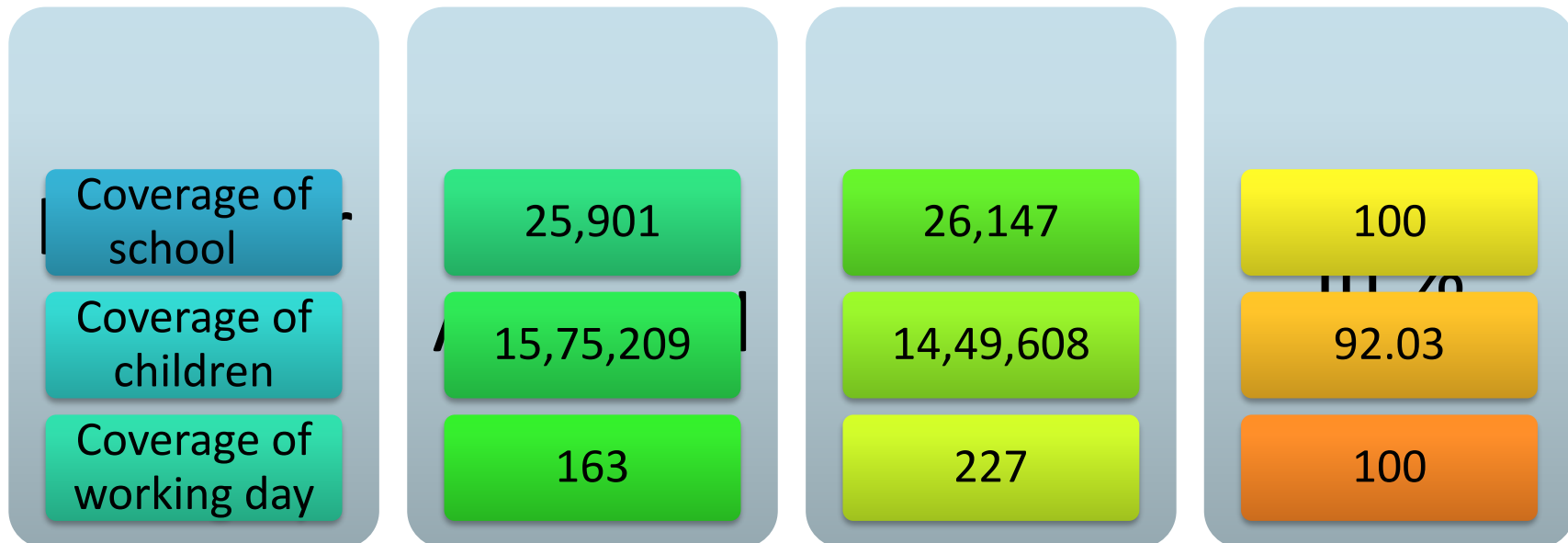

State Initiatives & Additional Financial Commitment by the State of Telangana



- State Government is providing egg thrice a week with additional Commitment of **Rs.126.77 Cr**



State Government is providing Super Fine fortified rice under PM POSHAN scheme with additional Commitment of **Rs. 149.17 Cr**



State Government has extended PM POSHAN Scheme to students studying in IX & X classes with additional Commitment of **Rs. 145.36 Cr**

RBSK Health Checkup

RASHTRIYA BAL SWASTHYA KARYAKRAM (RBSK)

300 RBSK teams have been constituted for visiting the schools and for Health Check-ups to the students.

The RBSK team consists of the following 4 members: 1) Male Doctor. 2) Female Doctor. 3) ANM 4) Pharmacist.

The RBSK teams are visiting the schools yearly once and providing Iron, Folic acid supplements and Calcium supplements to the students identified with the anaemia.

Under Anaemia Mukth Bharath Scheme, the RBSK Teams are conducting blood tests to identify the Haemoglobin percentage to students of classes VIII to X.

In certain schools battery of taps are provided for hand wash under Mana Ooru Mana Badi Programme.



Social Audit

Social Audit is conducted in 691 schools across all the 33 districts by CESS (Centre for Economic and Social Studies) in the month of January 2026.



School Nutrition Garden

- ❖ Kitchen gardens are developed in **15,694** schools in the State.
- ❖ Instructions are issued to all the Head Masters to establish School Nutrition Gardens wherever place is available.

Providing of Ragi Malt with Jaggery (Finger millet soup) – Supplementary Nutrition

- In the State of Telangana Ragi Jaava (Finger Millet Soup) is being provided to all the students of classes I to X on every alternate day in the schools before the morning prayer.
- The funding pattern being 40% by the Government under flexi funds and 60% by the Sri Sathya Sai Annapurna Trust.

The Secretary to Government, Education Department, Govt of Telangana and other Officers visited schools and observed the implementation of PM POSHAN Scheme.



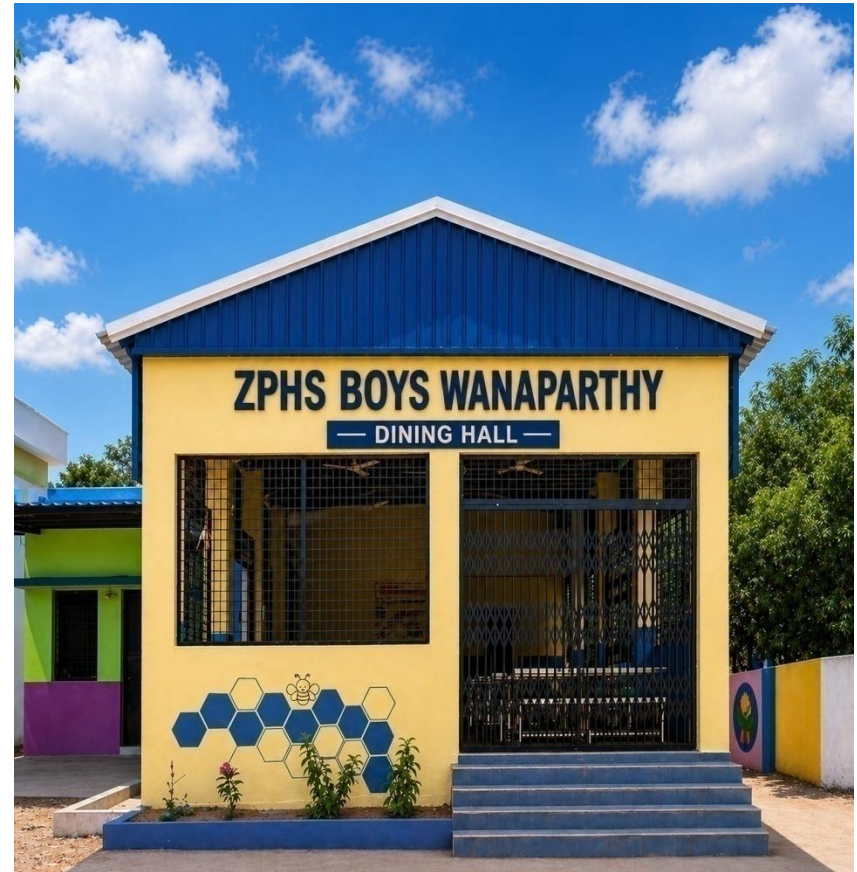

Construction of Dining Halls under Mana Ooru Mana Badi Programme

- In Telangana State, 532 schools are having Dining halls for having PM POSHAN.
- Under Mana Ooru Mana Badi programme, 2573 dining halls are sanctioned out of which 532 are completed and 2135 are in progress



Awareness of PM POSHAN Scheme and public participation

- ❖ In all the schools of State of Telangana every third Saturday of the month Parent-Teacher meetings are being conducted. During this Parent-Teacher meeting, implementation of the PM POSHAN Scheme is being observed by the Parents and any suggestions given by them are taken for consideration.
- ❖ The Senior Officers are visiting the schools and participate in the Parent-Teacher meetings.



Awareness of Scheme among the Mandal Educational Officers

- One-day orientation programme was conducted to all the Mandal Educational Officers in the State on **29.07.2025** and were given orientation on effective implementation of PM POSHAN.



Training to Cook –Cum Helpers

- Training was given to all the Cook-Cum Helpers by the community Science college (Home Science College), Saifabad, Hyderabad during the year 2025-26.



Cook-cum-Helpers cooking competitions

- Cooking competitions were conducted in 32 Districts and were given cash awards to the winners.



Organization of Food Festival

- Food festival was conducted in the schools on **21.12.2025** on the occasion of No Bag Day.



Tithi Bhojan

- Additional food items like sweet , fruit , chicken are given in Tithi Bhojan.
- Tithi Bhojan was organized in the schools on auspicious days.



Request to the Government of India

- To approve the budget for Rs. **374.88** Cr
(Central- **233.75** Cr, State- **141.13** Cr)
- To extend PM POSHAN Scheme to IX & X classes also.(Budget required is Rs. **145.36** Cr.)
- Separate budget for providing three eggs per week.
(Budget required is Rs. **126.77** Cr.)
- Separate budget for providing Supplementary Nutrition.(Budget required is Rs.**35.01** Cr.)
- Separate Budget for establishing School Nutrition Gardens.
- To enhance the rate of cooking cost.

New Initiatives of Telangana

- Separate Budget is provided by State Government to an extent of **Rs. 540 Crores** for providing of **Breakfast** to Students for Classes PP-X from the Academic year 2026-27. (230 Working days).
- Separate Budget of **Rs. 180 Cr** is provided by State Government for providing **Milk** to Students of Classes PP-X from the Academic year 2026-27 (230 Working days).
- **Green Channel:**
 - The MDM monthly bills are being generated by the MEO through an online system with effect from November, 2025.
 - The Head Master submits MDM details online to the MEO by the 2nd of every month.
 - The MEO, submits the bills Online to the Treasury/PAO before the 5th of every month.
 - The bills generated through the software are compatible with the IFMIS system for processing.
 - On the 6th of every month, State Finance Department has proposed to clear all the MDM bills.
 - Logins are being provided to the CCHs for verifying their regular payments.
