ORDERS UNDER SECTION 144 Cr.P.C.

Whereas it has been made appear to me that there is likelihood of causing tension, annoyance, obstruction or injury to persons, danger to human life and property, disturbance of public peace and tranquility within the limit of district Mahendergarh on account of General Elections, Lok Sabha, 2024.

And whereas it has been made to appear to me that the carrying of any weapons like licensed arms/fire arms, swords, Lathis, Barchhas, Bhallas, Kulharis, Jellies, Gandasis, Knives, Cycle Chains and other articles capable of causing injury and used as weapons of offence is likely to cause obstruction in the maintenance of public peace and tranquility in the area of Mahendergarh District, it has become necessary to prohibit carrying of above such weapons of offences and other articles capable of being used as weapons of offence (except Sheathed Kirpan) in the entire jurisdiction of the District Mahendergarh.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of the code of Criminal procedure, 1973, **I, Monika Gupta, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Mahendragarh** do hereby prohibit the carrying of weapons of offence like licensed arms/fire-arms, swords, Lathis, Barchhas, Bhallas, Kulharis, Jellies, Gandasis, Knives, Cycle Chains and other weapons (except Sheathed Kirpan used as a genuine religious symbol of Sikhs) in Mahendergarh District with immediate effect till completion of election process including the declaration of result. Further, I also prohibit carrying of mobile phones, wireless set, cordless phone or any other communication apparatus and assembly of more than five persons within 200 meters of all the Polling Stations/Counting Centres on 25.05.2024 and 04.06.2024 within the jurisdiction of District Mahendergarh.

This order shall not apply to the police and other public servants on duty.

In view of emergent situation and shortage of time, this order is passed ex-parte and is being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated within the limit of District Mahendergarh through publicity vans of the Public Relations Department; Publication in Newspapers; by fixation of copies of this order at District, Sub Divisional and tehsil courts, public places as well as the Police Stations.

The violation of this order is punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
