#### **Rights Perspective**

- Rights- enshrined in the Constitution of India
  - Fundamental Rights- cannot be alienated
  - Legal Rights- Not absolute



### RTI Scope

#### **Rights Perspective**

- Right to Information has been judicially recognized as part of Article 19(1)(a) of Indian Constitution
- "All Citizens shall have the right to freedom of Speech and Expression"
- For proper enjoyment of freedom of Speech and Expression, it is imperative that correct information is available to the Citizens.






#### **Rights Perspective**

- "Lack of Transparency was one of the main causes for all pervading corruption and Right to Information would lead to openness, accountability and integrity"-Soli Sorabji
- "Free flow of information from the Government to the people will not only create an enlightened and informed public opinion but also render those in authority accountable"

- My dreams have the right to know

   Why the blood flows in the streets, are we all not humans!

- Signatory to UN Convention on Human Rights
- Suitable Amendments to Official Secrets Act
- Democracy-of, by, for People



## Paradigm of Sequential Adoption, YP Singh & Uday Pareek



- Denial stage- stretching to 15 years
- Goa governor reverses decade-old stand on RTI, says will honor info requests
- Goa governor PS Sreedharan Pilli, who brought his office under RTI Act, said: "People are supreme rather than the governor, chief minister, or opposition leader... They are not the boss of the people".
- Case of o/o CJI of SC under RTI



- > RTI Fee drawn on "Accounts Officer IAF" was rejected
- CPIO- AF Naval Housing Board not PA (AoA is Ex-Officio chair)
- CPIO-AF School Sarsawa not a PA
- Non Public Fund Ventures- AFWWA, Canteen, AF Schools, etc not PA
- Pradip Solanki (Guj) land allotment case-don't ask information in question format?





- Organisation and Activity- Which is to be exempted?

  - Civil works in Defence establishment-BRO
  - Personnel matters- case of I&CAD Dept in Telangana
  - Procurement process





- Organisation and Activity- Which is to be exempted?
  - Vijay- Air accidents, causes, remedies-denied under 8 (1) (a) & (j)
  - Ronald Levis- Copy of notification of 116 DOC Course-deniedordered
  - Dalvir Singh-Court of inquiry, charges- denied 8 (1)(e)-ordered
  - Kunal Kumra-PR copy-denied 8 (1)(e) & (j)-ordered
  - Kirata Ram-Pension cases-denied-ordered





- Organisation and Activity- 3<sup>rd</sup> party
  - Air Force School-Run by Society (Info not held- can get from RCS)
  - Court martial records of Hindon Air Base-denied-ordered
  - Employee ID, Service book, etc-denied (father-in-law)

- In 15 years, RTI has gone from Indian citizens' most powerful tool to an Act on life support
- Chief Information Commission and its state counterparts have an unwritten rule about not penalising erring public information officers who discourage RTI applicants.



- Apply under RTI
- Obtain Information
- Visit Locations of information
- Joint verification
- Jan Sunvai (Public Hearing)
- Follow-up Action (recovery/disc . action)
- Ombudsman-mobile courts

## Learning Objective-4: Make RTI Non-Relevant

- Comply with Sec. 4(1)(b)
- Understand correct interpretation of Sec-8
- Review and revise all internal work processesmake them less discretionary
- Digitise all documents and keep them safe as per Dept codes
- Renew Internal inspection processes



## Learning Objective-4: Make RTI Non-Relevant

- Indicators to monitor
  - Number of cases coming to 1<sup>st</sup> appellate
  - Number of cases going to 2<sup>nd</sup> appellate
  - Number of cases going to courts





## Learning Objective-4: Make RTI Non-Relevant

- Drive away misnomers
  - RTI does not ask for information not held
  - RTI dos not ask for interpretation of act/rule
  - RTI does not set rules for holding records





#### **Transformation required**

Government Employee is no longer a Government Servant.

He/She has to transform to a *Public Servant* in Letter and Spirit.
