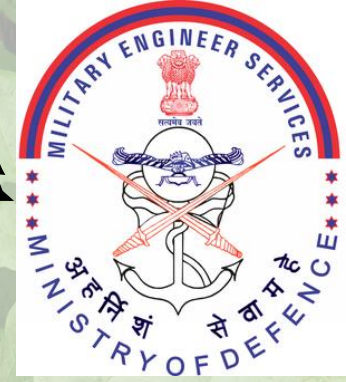

AIM

- To review their functions and understand the issues faced by them.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

- No of teachers working : 7
- No of students : 130
- SCERT Workbooks recently distributed (11TH Aug)- children found using it.
- Children were able to read the book and solve questions.
- Mid day meal food quality was found okay.
- Toilet condition improper (reason stated lack of Scavengers as they were removed during covid).
- Wood was used as fuel for cooking as there was no LPG connection.



HIGH SCHOOL

- No of teachers : 9
- No of Students : 168
- No of Aaya Workers: 2
- 10th in both medium English/Telugu
- Wood was used as fuel for cooking as there was no LPG connection.
- Mid day meal was not sufficient for all students (Many students brought their food from home) – HM said that only 9 Rs per student per day is provided for mid day meal which is very less.



HIGH SCHOOL

- Lack of TEACHING STAFF: COMPUTER CLASS, SCIENCE LAB(Lab Assistant), LIBRARIAN.
- Sports facility was decent.
- Computers, Stage and RO plant constructed by Old students.
- Toilet condition improper (reason stated lack of Scavengers as they were removed during covid).



ANGANWADI CENTRE

- No of Anganwadi centre: 5
- No of children: 173
- No of Pregnant women:29
- No of Lactating mother:23
- Daily Attendance taken.
- Egg / Milk provided daily to children
- Pregnant and lactating women are provided one full meal at the Anganwadi center and 30 egg given monthly.
- AWC 1- No aya present from last six month and no space for toilet.

PRIMARY HEALTHCARE CENTRE

- Primary treatment and check done from 9 AM to 4 PM
- Vaccination drive done to ensure maternal and child wellness (On regular intervals they call them to PHC. Also, Visit them in their home)
- KCR Kit given after birth.
- Ambulance facility available.

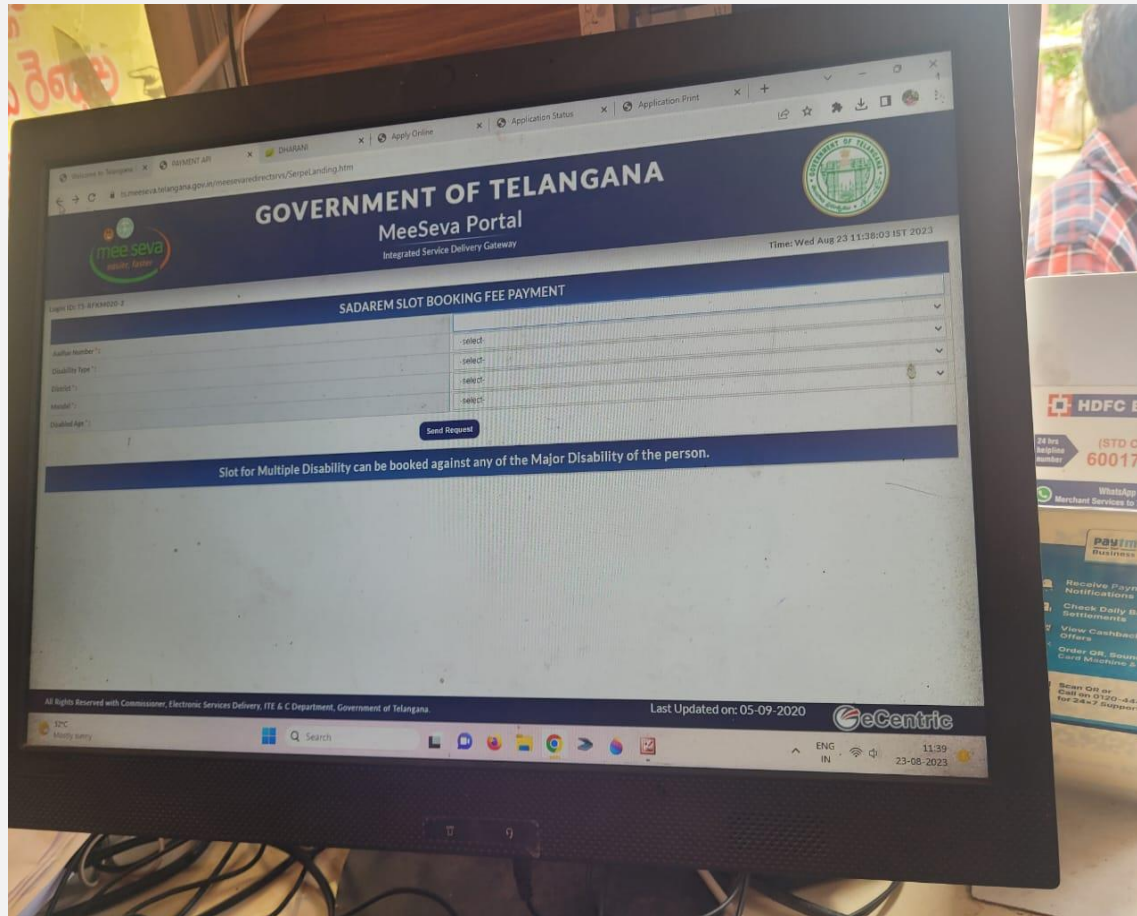

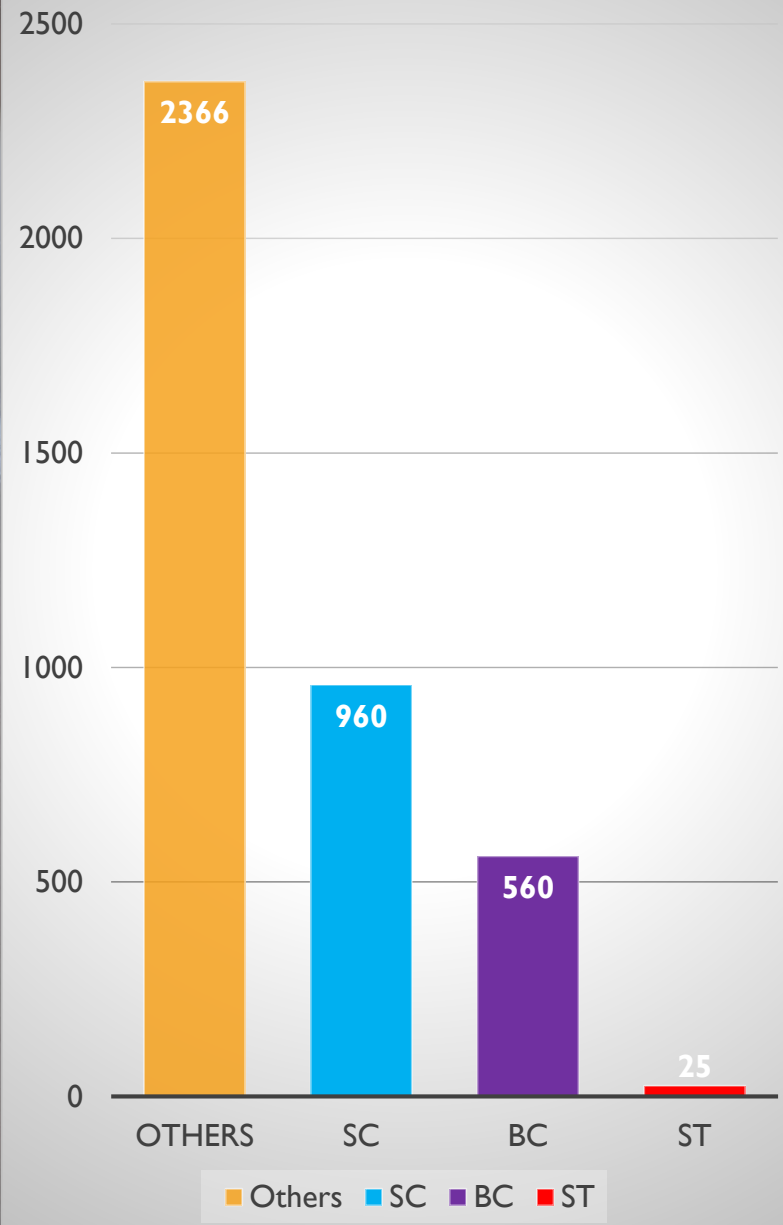
RESOURCE MAP

- Aim of this activity to know about different community areas and its resource bases like field, crops, land, pond and soil.



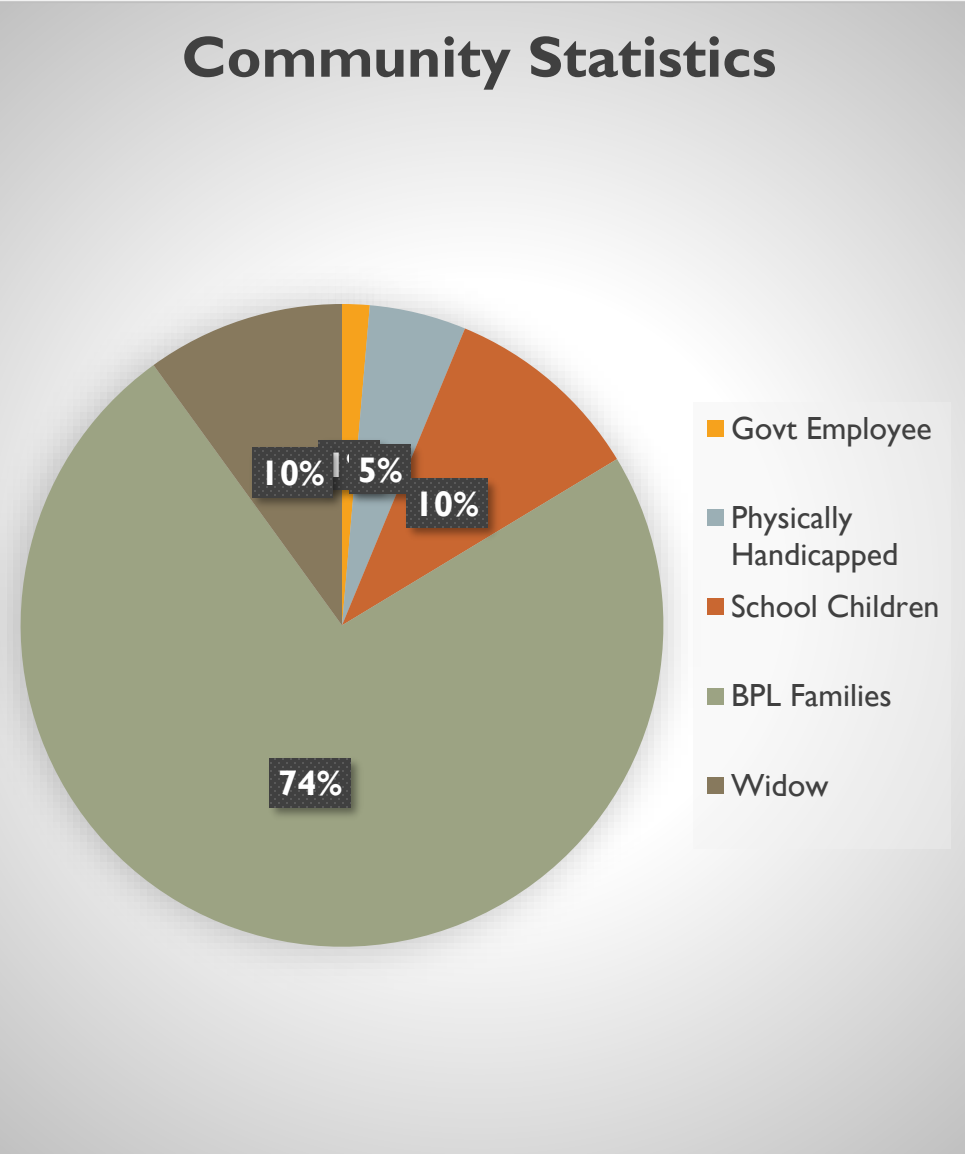
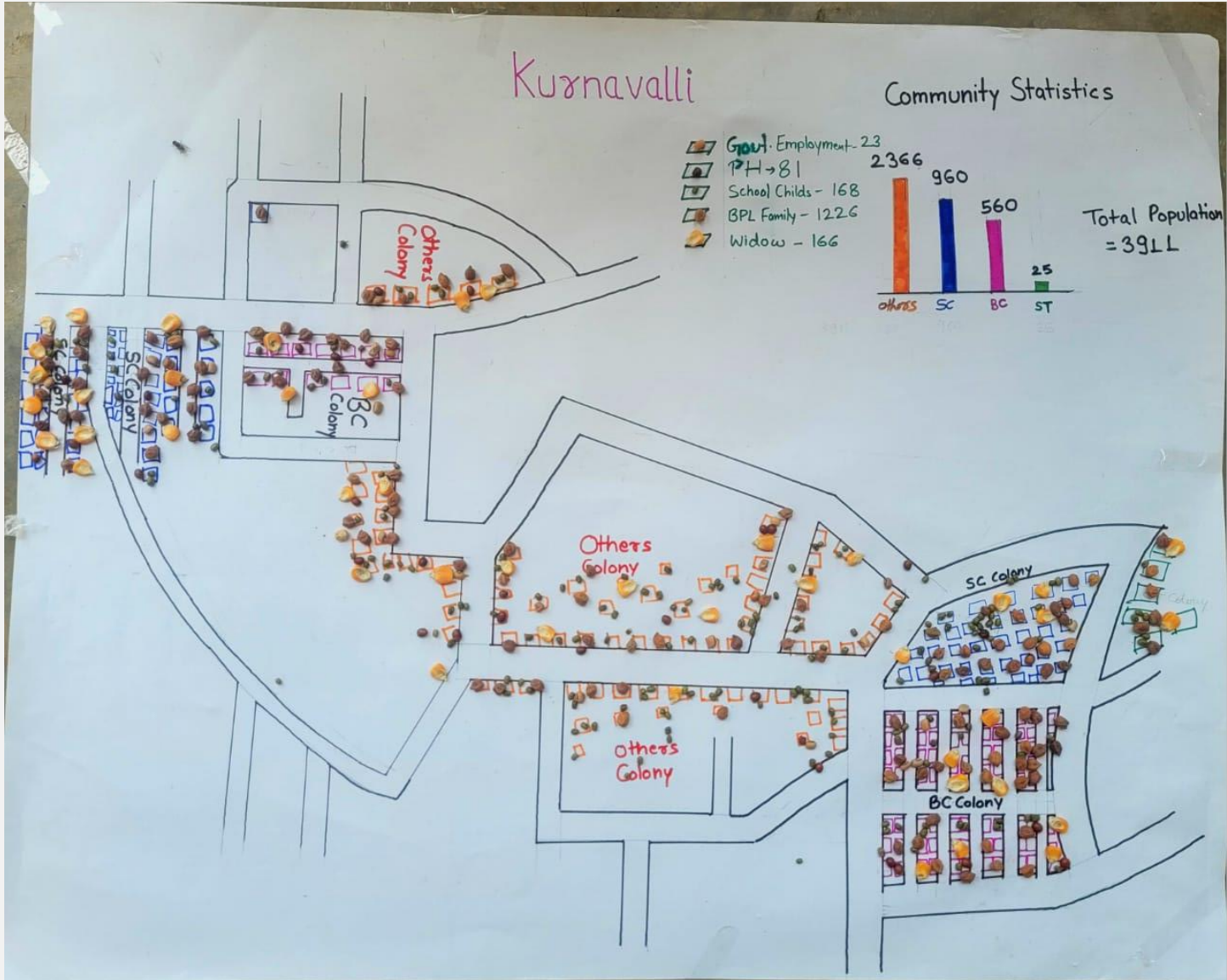

SOCIAL MAPPING

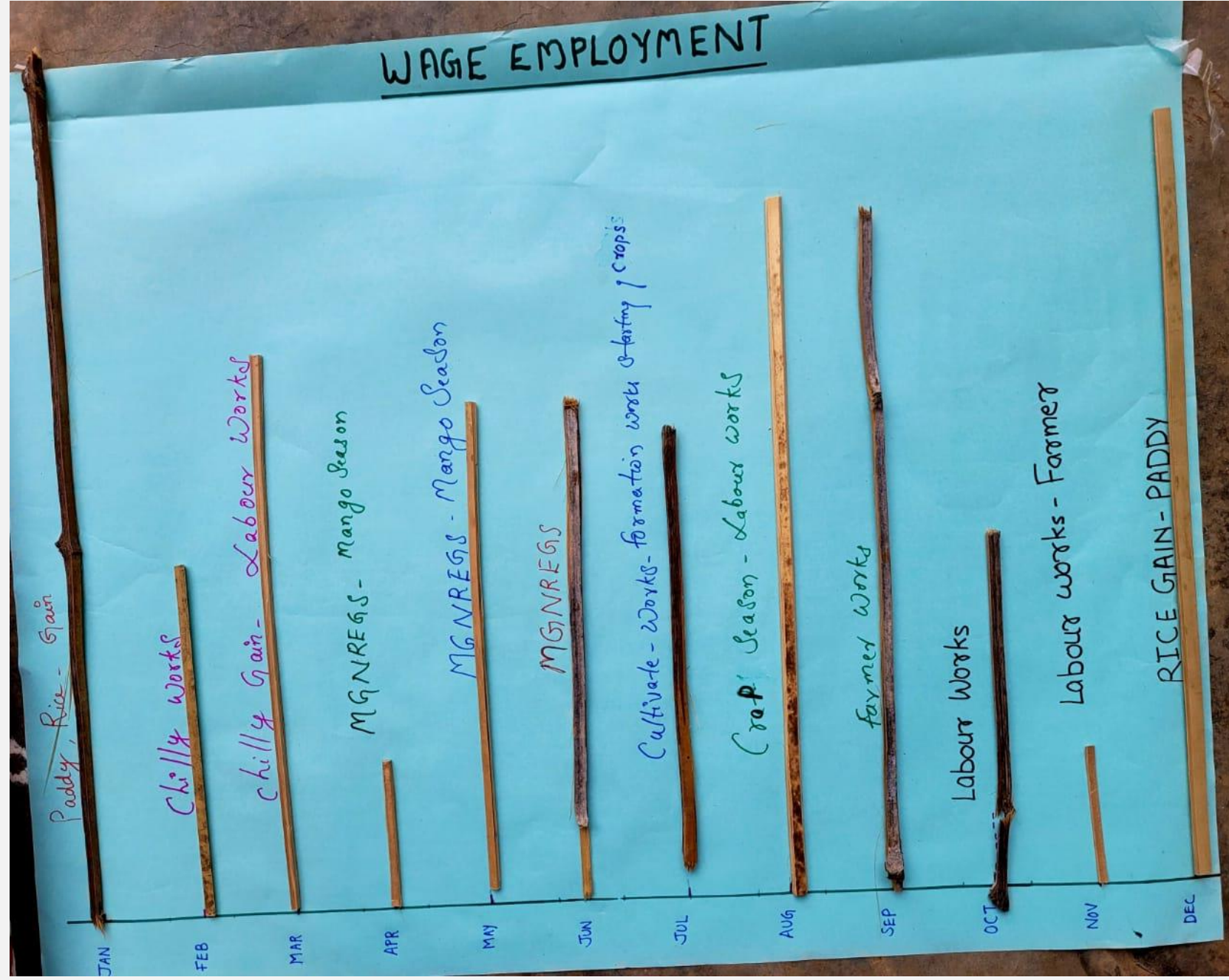


SEASONALITY

- Different parameters included- rainfall, wage employment, seasonal diseases

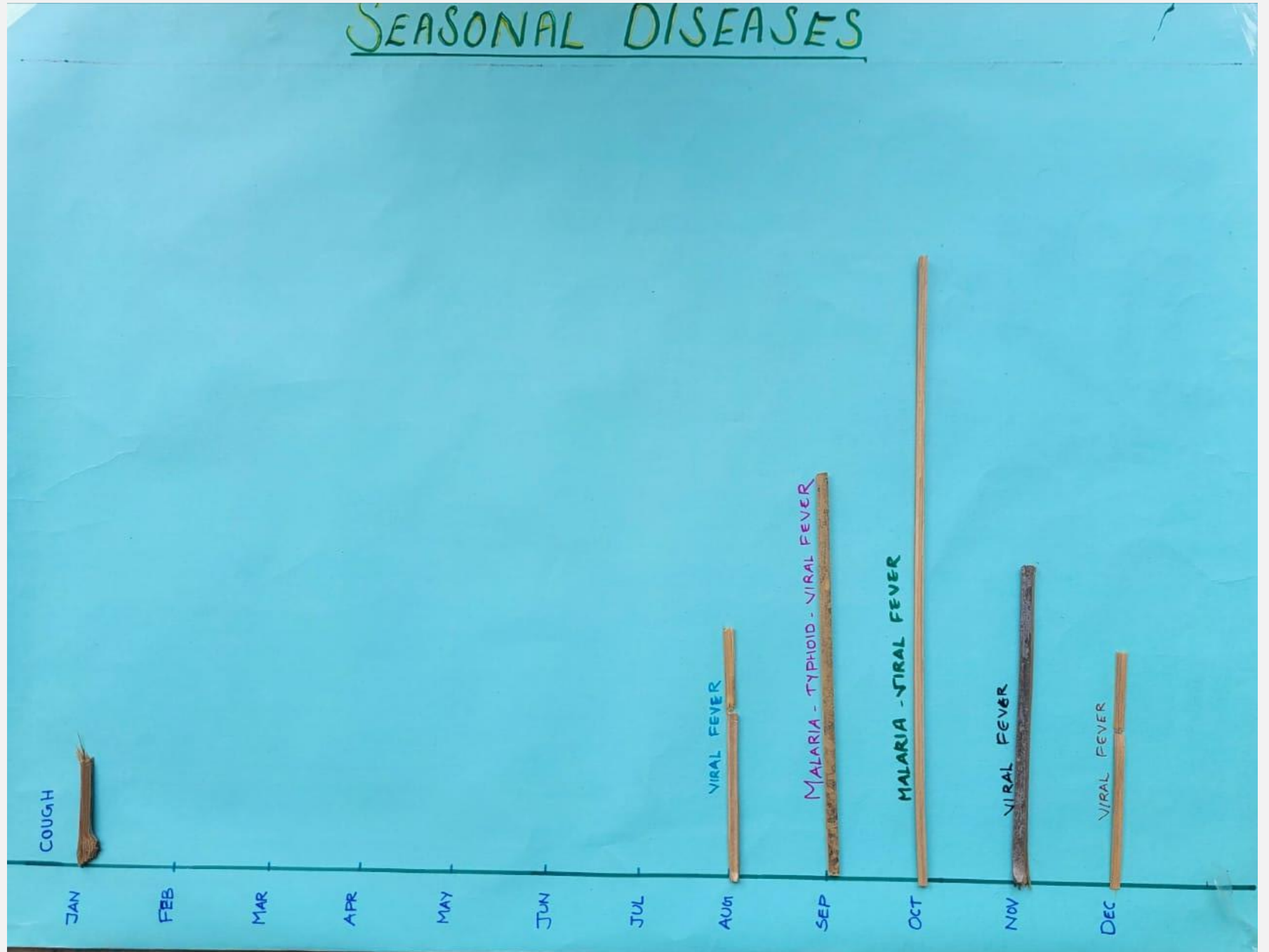


- Maximum wage employment months:- January, August, December
- From April to June villagers have MGNREGS work



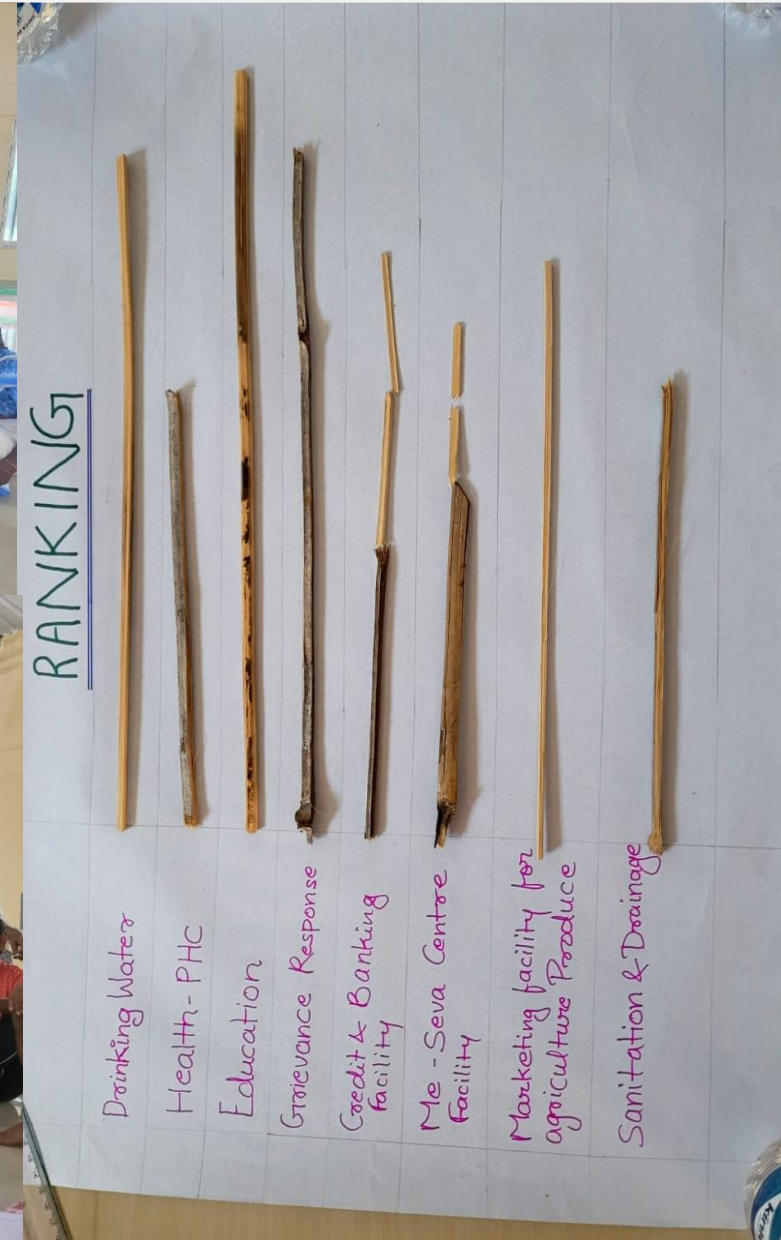
SEASONAL DISEASES

- Seasonal diseases:- viral fever, malaria, typhoid, cough

GOVT SCHEMES

MISSION BHAGIRATHA

- Under this mission provides piped drinking water to each household
- **Issues-**
- among four watertanks ,only two water tanks are functioning
- Improper pipeline system



MGNREGS

- Main objective of this scheme is to provide atleast 100 days wage employment per year and also to ensures minimum wage and getting payment within 15 days
- **Issues-**
- Provides no work to physically challenged people
- Some people are not getting payment within 15 days



MISSION KAKATIYA

- Main objective is to restore minor or medium irrigation tanks
- **Finding-** marri kuntha pond- area increased after restoration



MARRI KUNTHA POND

RYTHU BANDHU

- Direct farmer investment support scheme
- 5000 per acre per season for purchase of inputs like seeds, fertilizers, pesticides, labour and other investments twice a year for Rabi and kharif season
- Findings-almost 90 percentage of eligible households have been beneficiaries of this scheme

DUMPING YARD ,VERMICOMPOSTING

SHG

- There are 77 groups.
- Each group have 10 members.
- There is Village Organisation Assistant (VOA) under which 6-20 groups come.
- Starting amount of loan is Rs. 50,000/- & maximum eligible for 9 lakhs.
- Below 5 lakhs, there is no interest.
- Above 5 lakhs, 9% interest provided.
- Each group have two accounts- one is saving account and other one is loan account.
- Output of SHG, they invest money in Business, marriage, Agriculture, study, domestication, small shops etc.



TELANGANA KU HARITHAHARAM

- Main objective is to increase green cover from 24% to 33% and also ensures active participation of Grama panchayat



VAIKUNTHA DHAMAM



- Crematorium-dignified place for last rites
- Ecologically pleasant place
- There was waiting room and toilet facilities
- No place for Dalit communities

PALLE PRAGRATI VANAM

- Pleasant place for community gathering
- Greenery place
