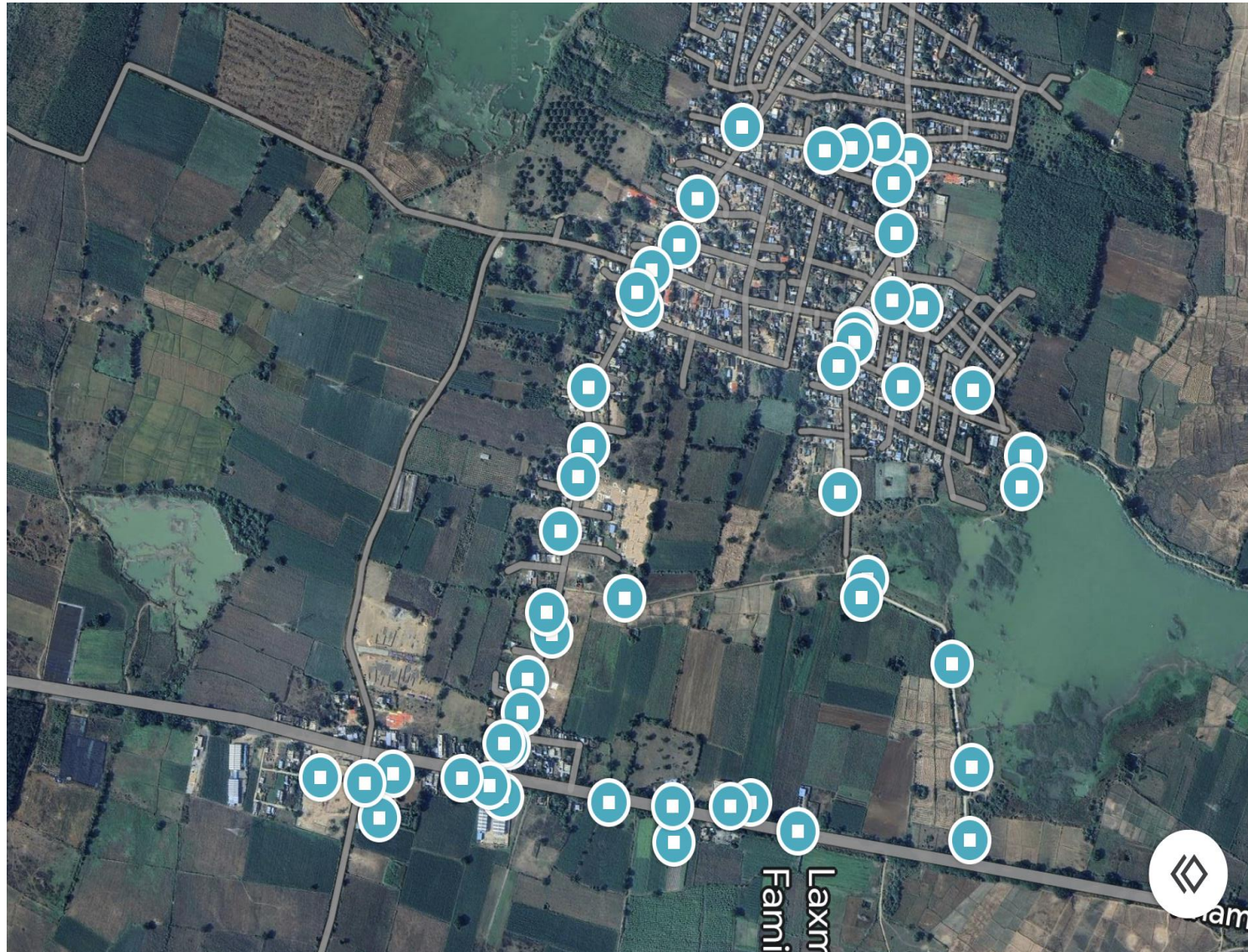

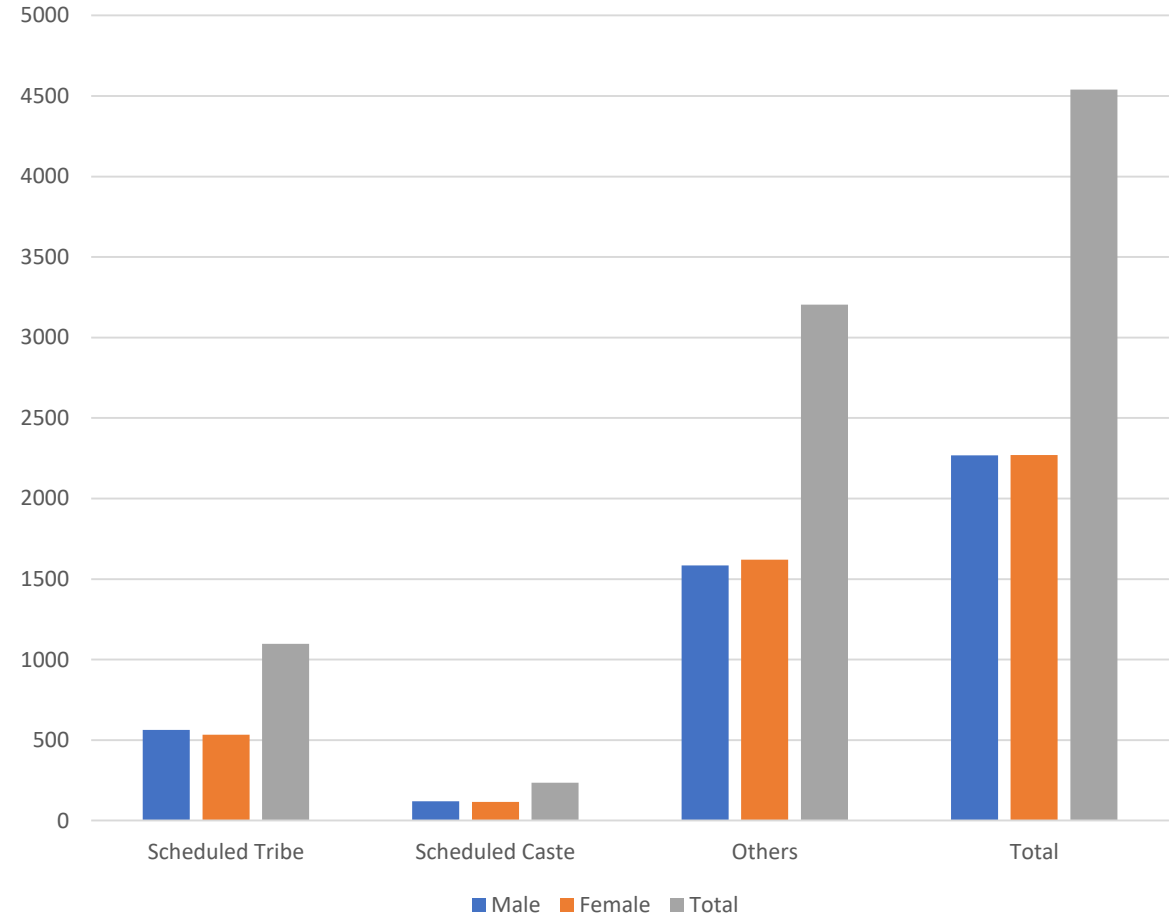

## PHC

4. Average 15-20 patients per day
5. Institutional deliveries are not performed there and referred to PHC Kamepalli

# RYTHU VEDIKA

## RYTHU BIMA

The main objective of the Farmers Group Life Insurance scheme (Rythu Bima) is to provide financial relief and social security to the family members/dependents.

Farmers in the age group of 18 to 59 years are eligible for enroll under the scheme.

In the event of the death of the enrolled farmer due to any cause including natural death.

The insured amount of Rs. 5.00 Lakhs is deposited into the designated nominee account within 10 days.

## RYTHU BANDHU

Farmers Investment support scheme

⇒ It is a welfare programme to support farmers investment for two crops a year by the Government of Telangana.

⇒ The Government is providing Rs. 5000/- per Acre per season to support the farm investment twice a year for rabi and kharif seasons.

⇒ This is first Direct Farmers Investment support scheme in India, where the cash is paid directly.

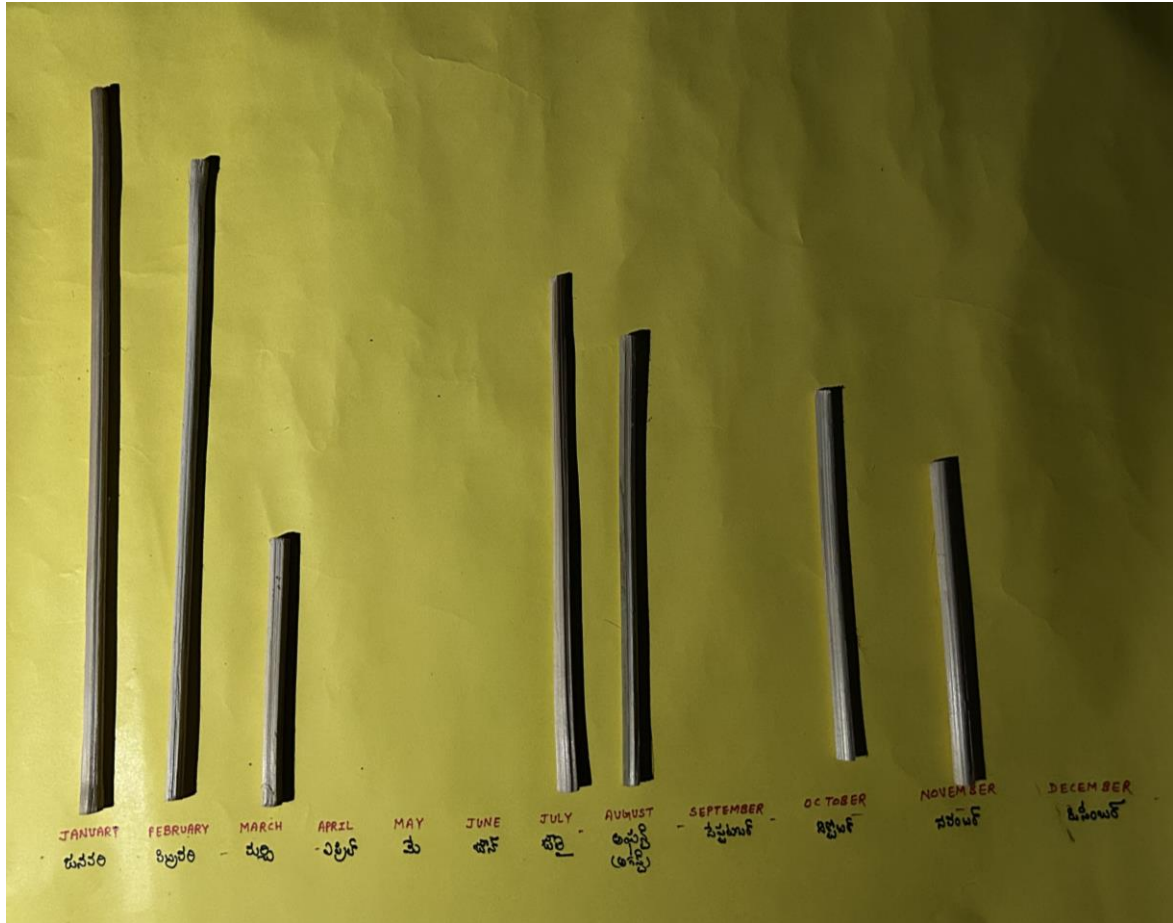

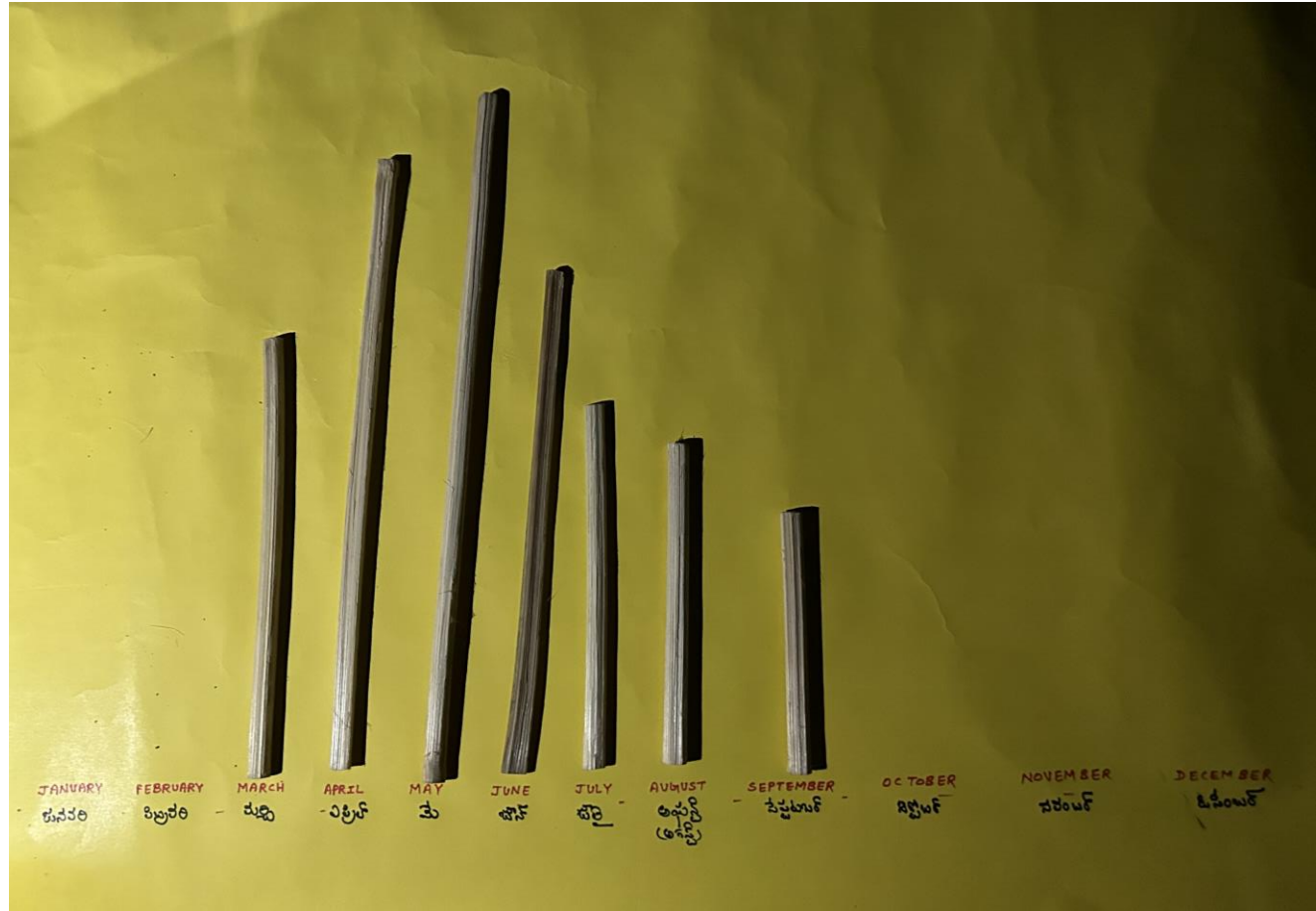


**SEASONAL DISEASES**





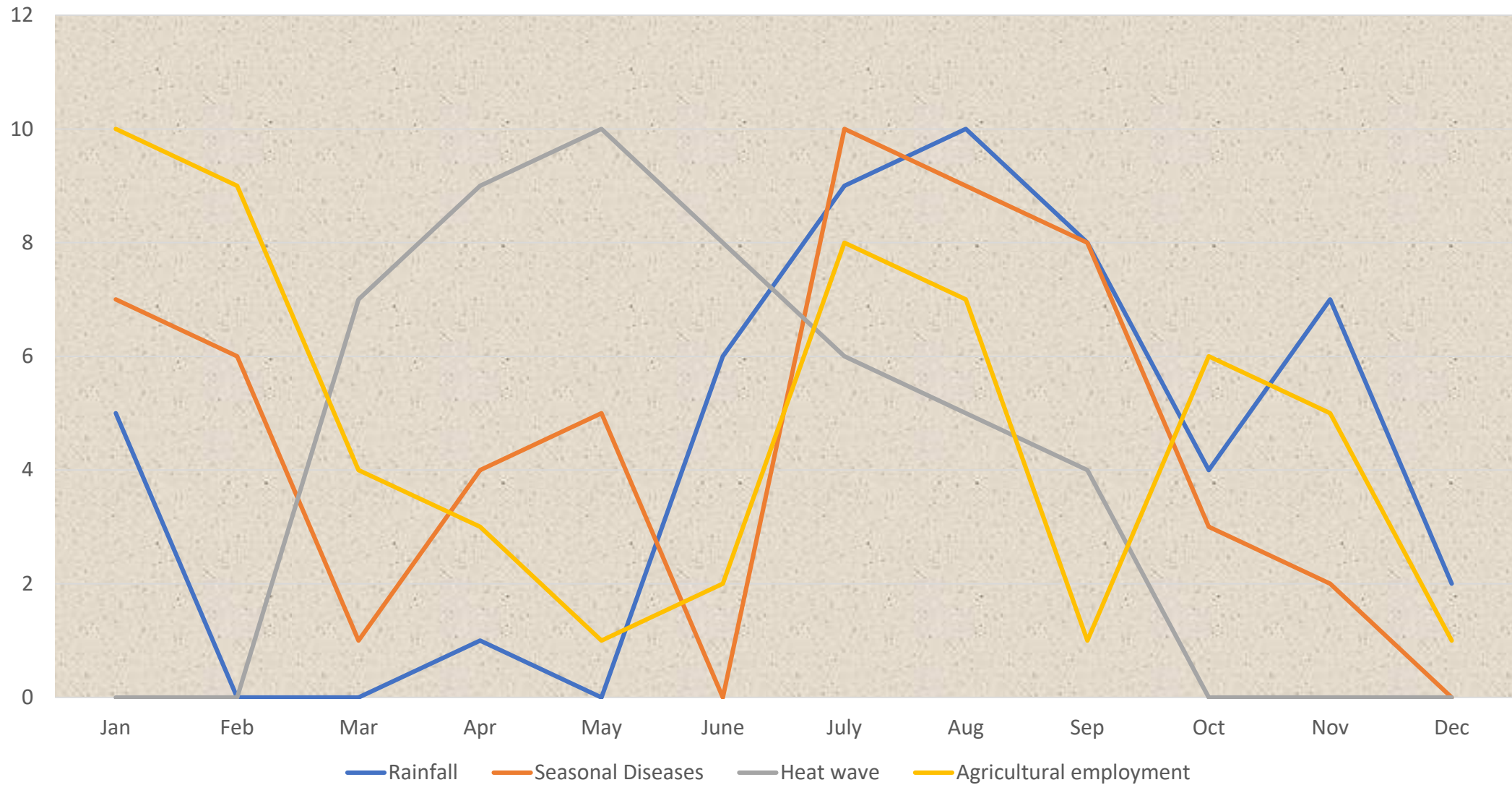

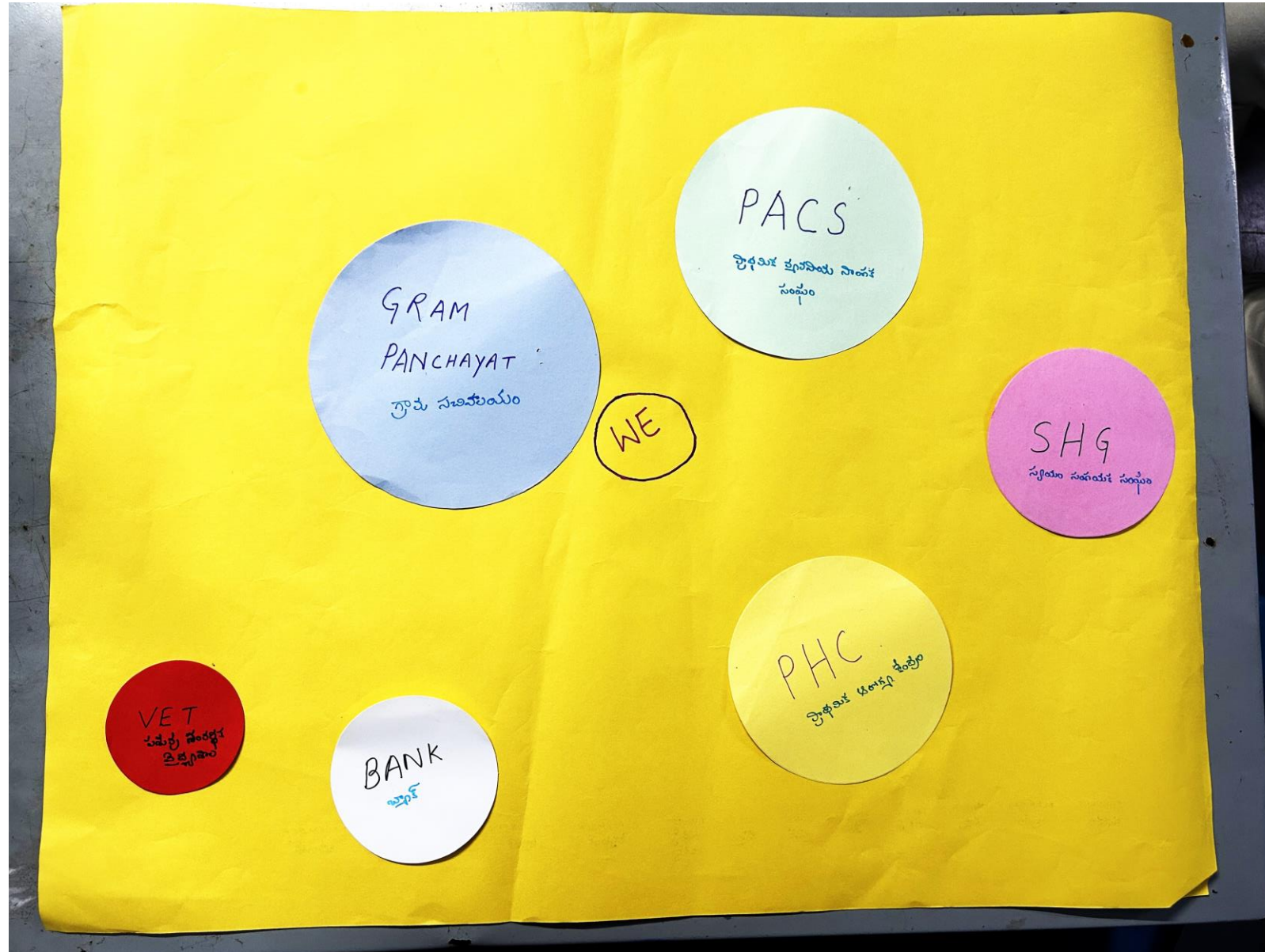

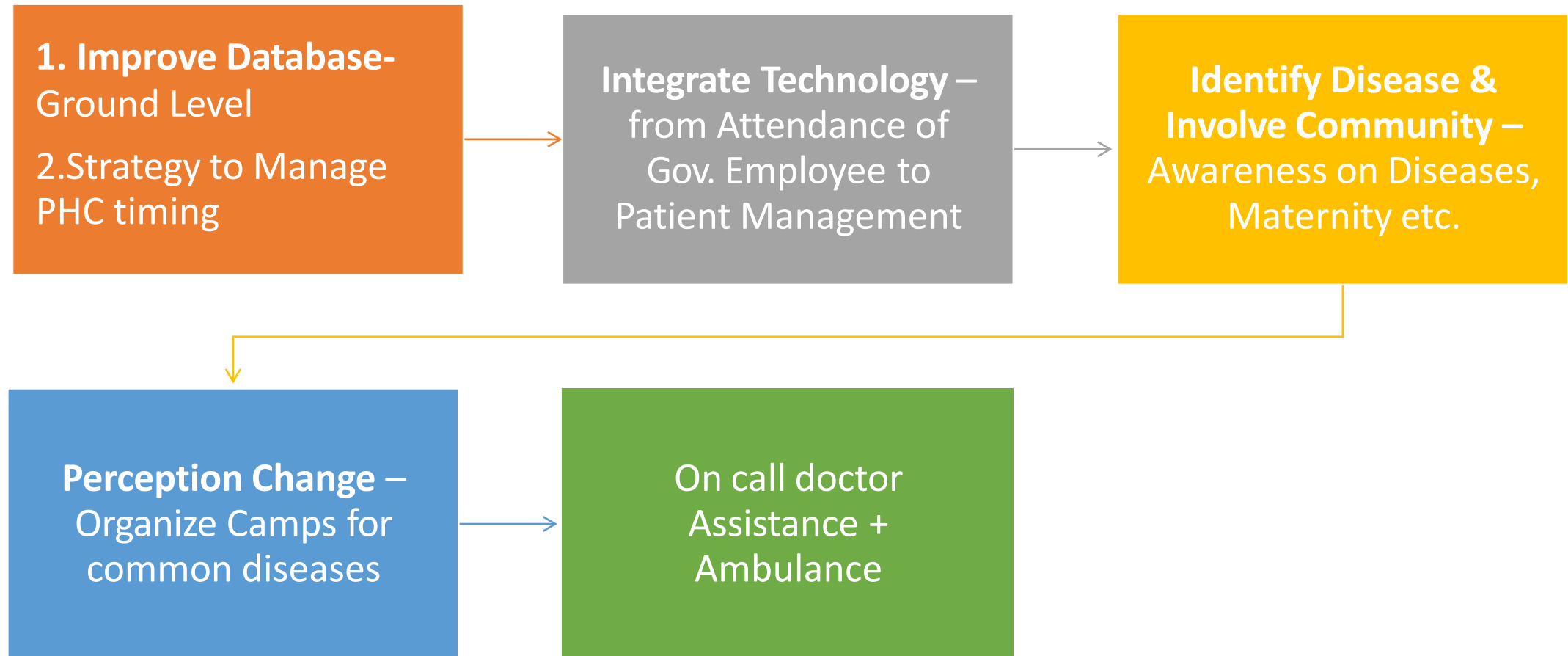


# VENN DIAGRAM



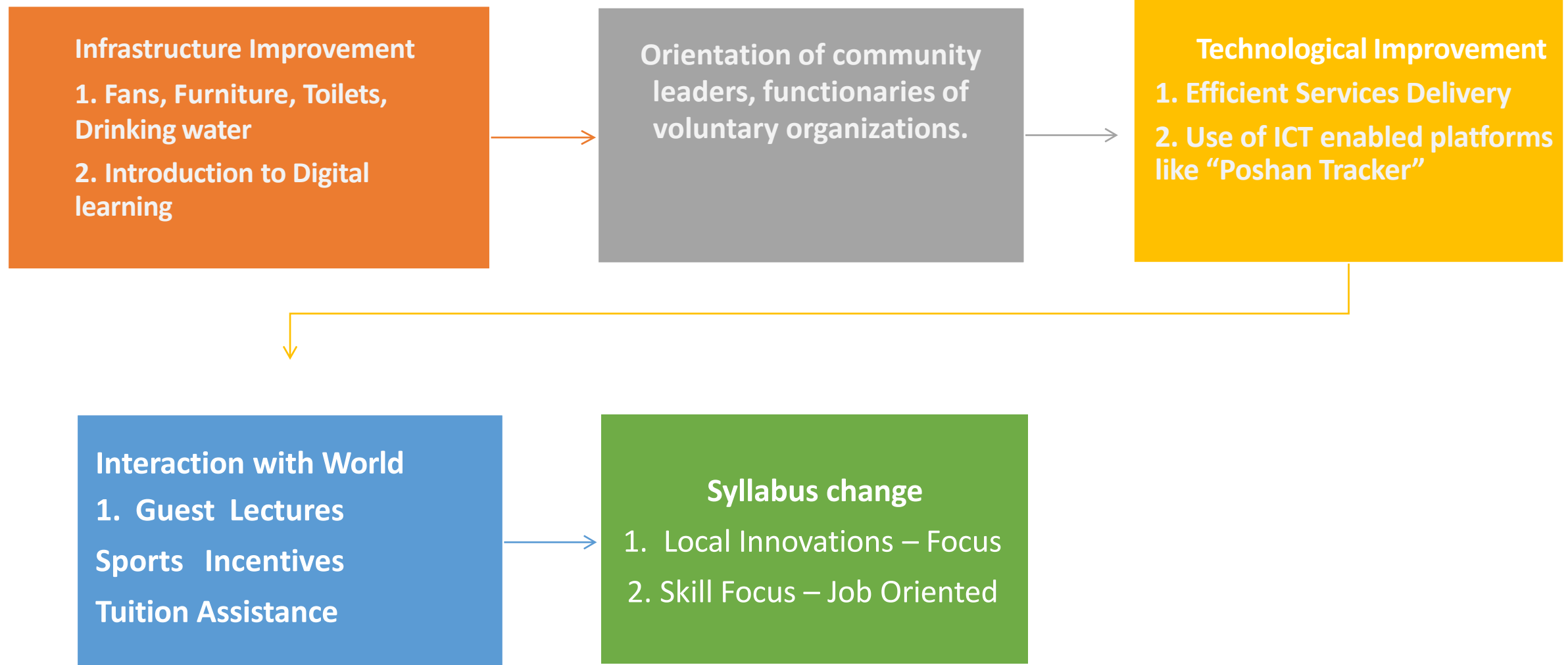
