





CITYWIDE CRIME RATE: 1985-2017







India's position slips among the world's fastest-growing economies



Round system is followed. Usually 1 year or 6 months.





India has the largest chunk of global poor




Of the individual countries for which estimates are available, no other country crosses 5% of the global poor irrespective of the line chosen.








Impact of Household Consumption Expenditure


