Hostels (BC Girls Hostel and SC-ST Boys Hostel). • Library with a reading room and computer facilities. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Anganwadis are in a state of despair. 3/8 anganwadis run on a rented place with lack of basic facilities like drinking water, electricity, sanitation etc. • Computer facilities not available in govt. schools. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Primary school needs repair. • Provision of permanent structures for Anganwadis with all the basic amenities. • Need for leveraging ICT to ensure better learning outcomes.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sex ratio = 1006 females per 1000 males. • Aasara pensions to widows, single women, destitute women. • 4 Mahila Parishads and 226 SHGs and several Village Organizations • Women are active participants in the labour force. (Selling chicken and fish, owners of vegetable shops, beedi workers and in Mulkanoor Women's Cooperative Dairy.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Female literacy only 58% compared to male literacy of 78%. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More incentives need to be provided to attract the females to schools. • Adult teaching programmes.

Largely the toilets are privately funded with few constructed under the Swachh Bharat Mission. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Water shortages during summers. • Ground water has large amount of fluoride content. • Open drainage system with no interconnection • Non Availability of Toilet facility in Anganwadi Centre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implementation of rain water harvesting techniques at community and household levels. • Proper drainage system should be constructed. • Proper waste disposal.

Padala Gautam. • Ban on the use of plastic. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large part of agriculture is water and fertilizer intensive. • The ban on use of plastic hasn't been fully enforced. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of organic farming should be promoted and incentivise. • Fertilizers and inoculants should be made at bigger level and distributed among the farmers to promote organic farming. • More awareness regarding harmful effects of plastics should be done. • Regular checks and fines should be imposed on use of plastic. • SHGs should made to take workshops on preparation of paper bags.

Regular bonus are provided to the employees. • 72 women work as Beedi Workers with regular wages of Rs 2016 per month. • There is a Saturday bazaar which is regulated by women alone. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The unemployment problem is on a rise. Youth with graduation and B. Tech are having difficulties to get jobs and is leading to rising migration. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Job prospects should be created in the village itself. • Skill development plan to be introduced. • Encouraging IT and software industries for rural branching. • Incorporation of educated unemployed youths into education system.

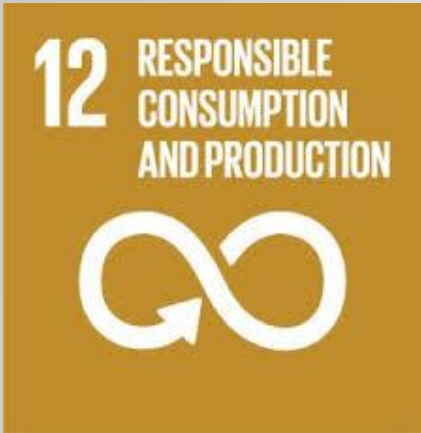
