Objective of the Program

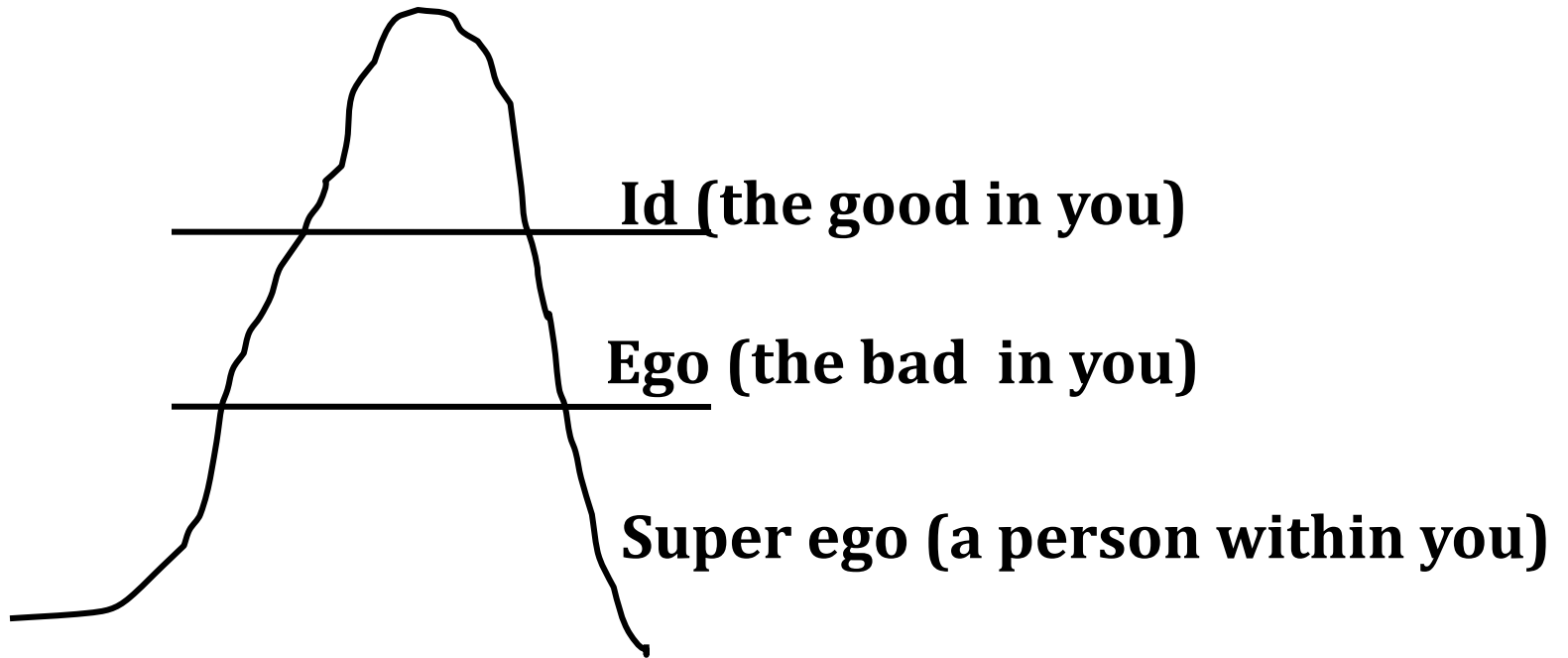
