
All the Officer Trainees (OTs) are expected to be properly attired at all times, and

Institute's Dress Code: Occasions- 5



I. CEREMONIAL OCCASIONS:

- Course Inauguration / Valediction Ceremony
- Visit of VVIPs such as President / Vice President / Prime Minister
- Any other occasion designated so specially by the Course Team.

a. DRESS FOR MEN OTs:



Jodhpur Suit: Black, White or light colour, OR


Lounge Suit: Two or Three piece, and

Formal Shoes (Oxford or Brogues)









SINGLE BREASTED TWO BUTTON SUIT

The top button must be fastened when standing and the second button should never be fastened.

Jacket must be unbuttoned when seated.

SINGLE BREASTED THREE BUTTON SUIT

There are two options. When standing, fasten top two buttons and leave the third unfastened or fasten only the middle button.

b. DRESS CODE FOR WOMEN OTS:



Saree OR Western Business Suit, and Formal shoes / sandals.

II. FORMAL OCCASIONS:

- Formal Lunch / Dinner
 (other than those where a VVIP is present)
- Visits of dignitaries other than VVIPs

a. Dress for Men:

- Black or White or light colour <u>Jodhpur</u> <u>Suit</u> or
- 2 or 3 piece <u>Lounge Suit</u> (preferably in dark colors)
- with necktie/ cravat and formal shoes

b. Dress for women

- Saree or Salwar Kameez
- Churidar & Kurta / Kameez

III. INFORMAL OCCASION

- Class Hours when authorized.
- Visiting / Receiving Guests

a.For Men

Formal full sleeves shirts and formal trousers (without necktie).

b. For Women

- Plazzo and kurta / kameez
- Kurta and Nehru Jacket with churidar
- Formal shirt, shoes / sandals











IV. CASUAL OCCASIONS:

- Cultural Evenings
- Mess
 (Other than for Formal Lunch / Dinner)
- Track Suit is a Sports dress and hence track suits are not allowed in cultural program and Dining Hall

a. Dress for Men:

Open collar shirt with trousers and shoes (other than sports shoes/ sneakers)

b. Dress for Women:

- Kurta with leggings
- Long Skirts
- Casual Trousers, Shirts, Top
- Foot wears (other than chappals / sneakers)
