
- Famous for 2 Temples


MGNREGA

- Agriculture only in rainy seasons.
- Men goes to city for daily work.
- All 33 members were ladies.
- They worked from 6:30-12 noon (6 hrs approx)
- Complaining about the hard work, there hands were getting hard.
- No tools and instruments were provided.
- Daily wages were really low. They were paid based on the amount of work done.
- Final wages turned out to be Rs 150-200 per day plus 10% TA.
- No drinking water facility and sanitation facility available at site.




Rural Connectivity

- 50% of internal area was covered through CC roads.
- 50% were gravely roads.
- No road work was carried out under PMGSY scheme.
- All roads were through state funds.



Housing Facility

- 10% of the houses where Mud/Kacha houses.
- Remaining houses were Pucca houses.
- The main issue was the density of people in each houses.
- Double bed housing scheme by govt of Telangana where by 60 bedded houses were being constructed.
- Allocation through draw system.
- According to Sarpanch 500 more such houses will serve the village purpose.




Agriculture

- People did agriculture only during the rainy season which lasted for 3-4 months
- No irrigation facility was available.
- According to Rythu Bandhu Scheme, Govt. of Telangana is providing Rs 8000/acre of land holding.
- However cotton, paddy, red gram and maize were grown during rainy season.



Issues in education sector

- People are very poor. They prefer to send only male child to the private school and girl child to either govt school or no school.
- Large no of dropouts due to early death of father in the family.
- School infrastructure and hostel facilities required improvement.
- No electricity in the Primary School.



Swachh Bharat Mission



• Present status:

- Not an ODF village
- No community toilets
- Common dumping yards 01
- No dustbins at road junctions

• Proposed Steps:

- Two dustbins per household
- Deployment of more sanitation workers



Drinking Water

- RO Plant (Water ATM) 5000 Lt/Hr.
- Established by Sri Jain SWE Tirth Temple.
- Sources of water Borewells and Overhead Tanks.
- Tanks constructed under Mission Bhagiratha.
- Water is supplied through the pipes under the PWS Scheme.

The rates for drinking water are:

- Private: 5 /20 litres
- Trust : 3 /20 litres
- 10 extra for home delivery









Sanitation

- 2-3 houses have a common septic tank incorporated with soak pits for solid waste.
- Grey water is disposed off in the fields.
- Garbage is dumped alongside the roads and collected by Municipal Corporation once in a month.





Electrification

- There is a 132/33 KV substation established in year 1975.
- It supplies electricity to about 40 villages including Kolanpak village and also to Railway Traction.
- The total load of Kolanpak is around 2 MW.
- The blackouts in the village are very rare and there is almost a 24 Hrs. continuous supply.



Electrification

- Around 90% of the houses had Electricity connection with energy meters.
- Remaining households are being provided under Saubhagya Scheme.
- There were LEDs hanging from the poles. They were switched ON continuously 24*7 leading to wastage of Energy.
