

 - **Mission Indradhanush** : Every child is immunized

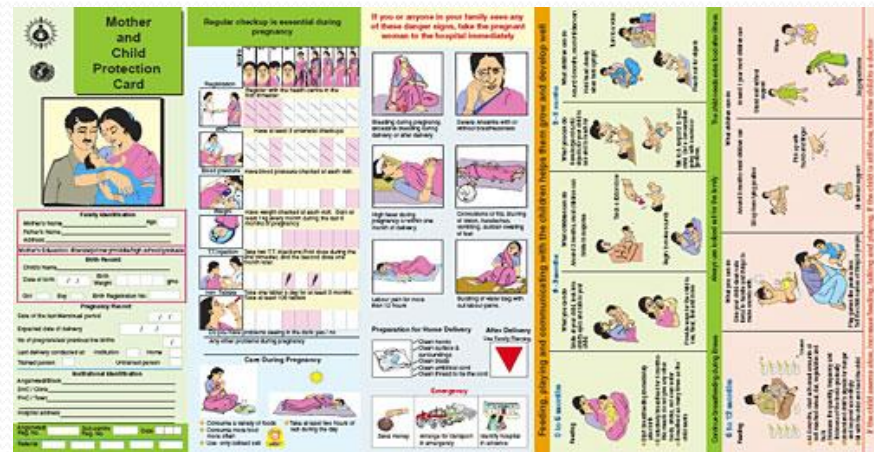
MCPC (Mother Child Protection Card)

- 4th dose in 10th month

Beneficiaries

KCR kit

Key features

- KCR kit contains 16 items that are sufficient for 3 months which includes baby care products to keep them warm and hygienic
- Rs. 13000 - Girl child
- Rs. 12000 – Boy child

MISSION KAKATIYA

- In 2014
- The tanks and lakes are dug to remove silt for increasing water storage capacity
- The silt or soil that is rich in nutrients gets transferred to the farmers to their fields
- It got implemented in four phases



Phase 1:-

1. Chennareddy cheruvu

- Main component – de-silting in bed area

2.Papa kunta

- Main component- band strength, de-silting in bed area

Phase 2:-

Ram Reddy kunta

- Main component: - band strength, de-silting in bed area

Phase 3:

kamasani kunta

- Main component- band strength, de-silting in bed area
