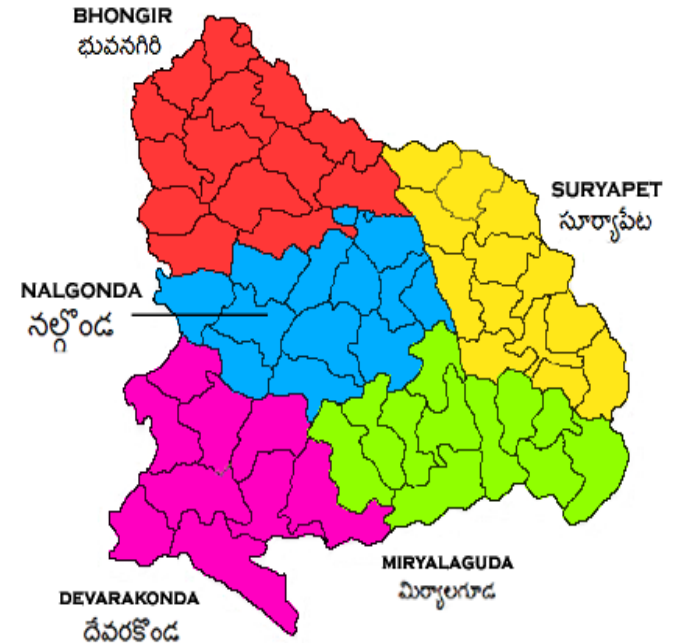

MAP NOT TO SCALE

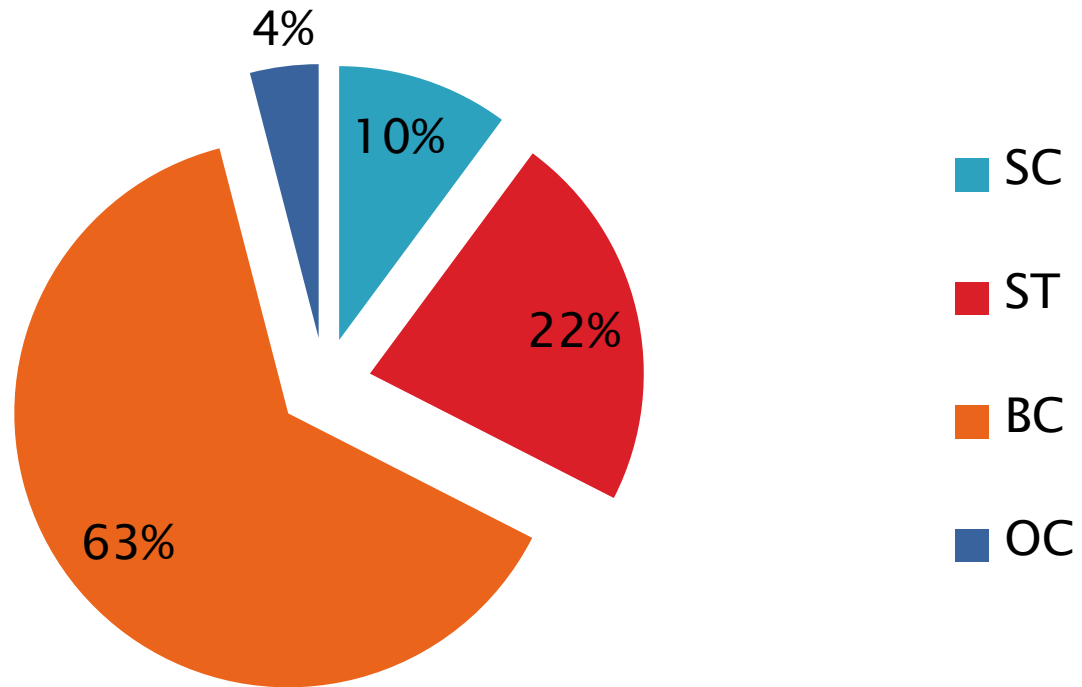
KHUDABAKSHPALLY – A Brief Profile

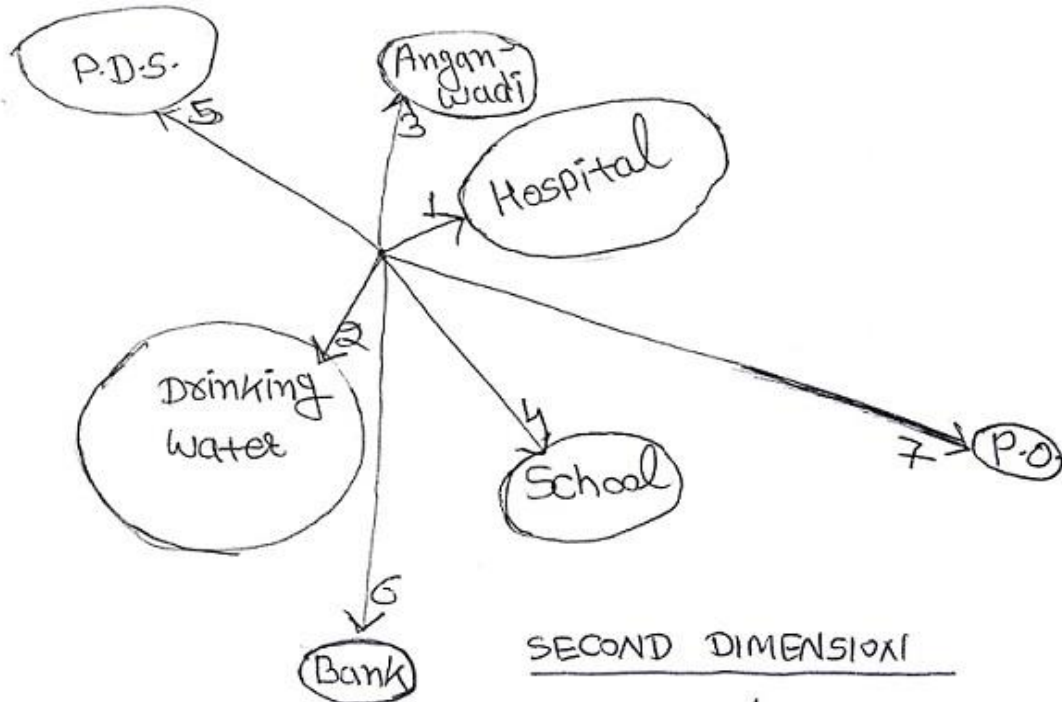

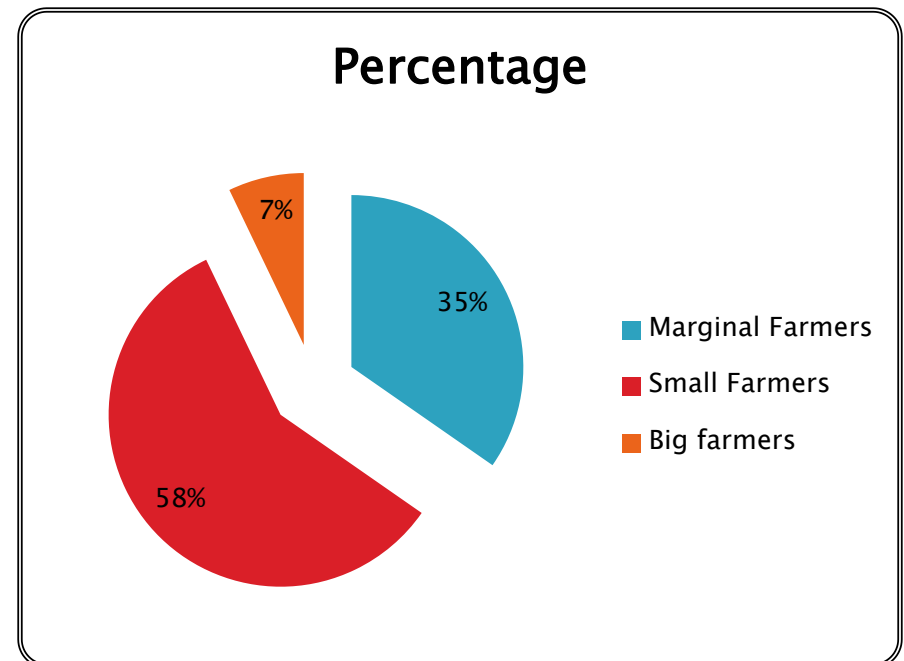

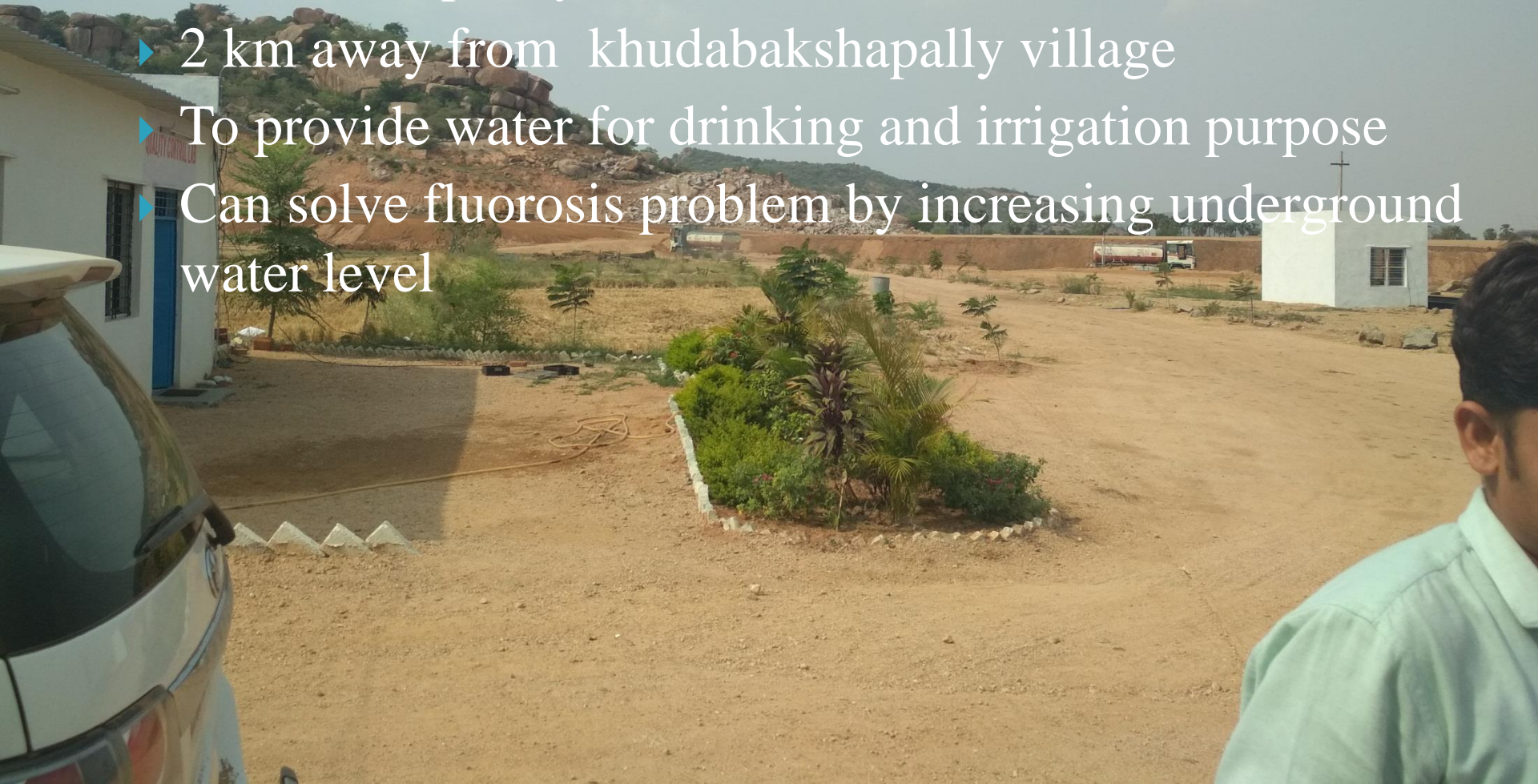

20 households have got the connection and 15 more connections are under process

universal household electrification in the country

Implementation

All the households of the Village already have electricity connection

promote efficient lighting to reduce electricity consumption

- **Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana**

Central government life insurance scheme

Implementation

Less participation of poor economic status villagers

- **Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana**

Central Government accident insurance scheme

Implementation

Closure of scheme for non maintenance of minimum balance
(Poor Communication)

- **Mission Indradhanush**

Aims to immunize all children under the age of 2 years as well pregnant women against 7 vaccine preventable diseases

Implementation

Substitute for this scheme is already being implemented by State government

STATE GOVERNMENT SCHEMES

- ▶ **Mission Bhagiratha**

Providing safe drinking water facility for every household

Implementation

Water pipes are being laid

- ▶ **Deepam Scheme**

Substitute for UJJWALA Scheme.

Implementation

Effectively being implemented.

- ▶ **Rythu Bandhu**

Welfare program to support farmer's investment for two crops a year

Implementation

Running effectively as all farmers are getting benefited.



STATE GOVERNMENT SCHEMES

▶ **Aasara Pension**

Welfare scheme of pensions to old people, widows, Goud community, Elephantiasis patients, HIV positive people, physically disabled and beedi workers.

Implementation

There are about 600-700 villagers getting benefitted.

▶ **Kalyan Laxmi / Shaadi Mubarak Scheme**

A welfare scheme for providing financial assistance for marriages of girls

Implementation

Approximately 20-25 marriages solemnized in a year in the village.

▶ **Double Bedroom Housing Scheme**

A housing scheme for the poor by the Government of Telangana

Implementation

30 houses have been sanctioned to this village but yet to be implemented.

OBSERVATIONS

- ▶ Good infrastructure facilities like electricity, roads, transportation etc.
- ▶ Communal harmony
- ▶ Proper functioning of Anganwadi institutions.
- ▶ Functional SHGs leading to women empowerment in the village.
- ▶ Connectivity of internet under progress.




OBSERVATIONS(Contd..)

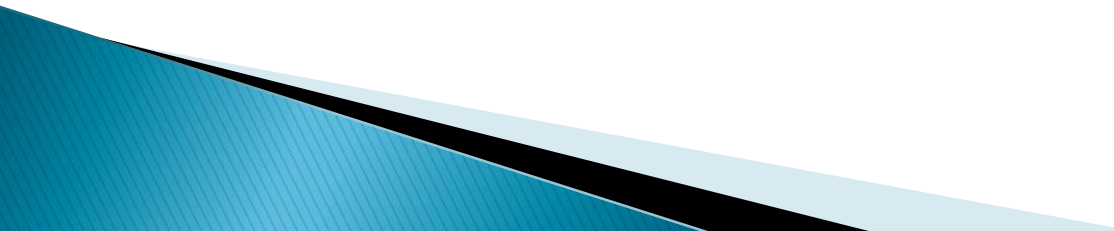
- ▶ No bank or ATM in the village.
- ▶ No hospital nearby for emergency cases.
- ▶ Farmers are bound to sell their crops at prices below the MSP to the moneylenders.
- ▶ Unemployment
- ▶ High fluorine content in water causing Fluorosis disease.



SUGGESTIONS

- ▶ Awareness of government schemes among the villagers.
 - ▶ Establishment of Bank and financial institutions.
 - ▶ Top Priority to implement mission Bhagiratha.
 - ▶ Introduction of English medium education at primary school.
 - ▶ Improvement of quality of rice supplying to Aanganwadis.

- ▶ Improvement in primary school infrastructure.
 - ▶ Provide better employment opportunities
 - ▶ Awareness regarding crop loans among the farmers.
