- Got its name from 16<sup>th</sup> century sultan of bijapur “Ali Adil Shah-I”

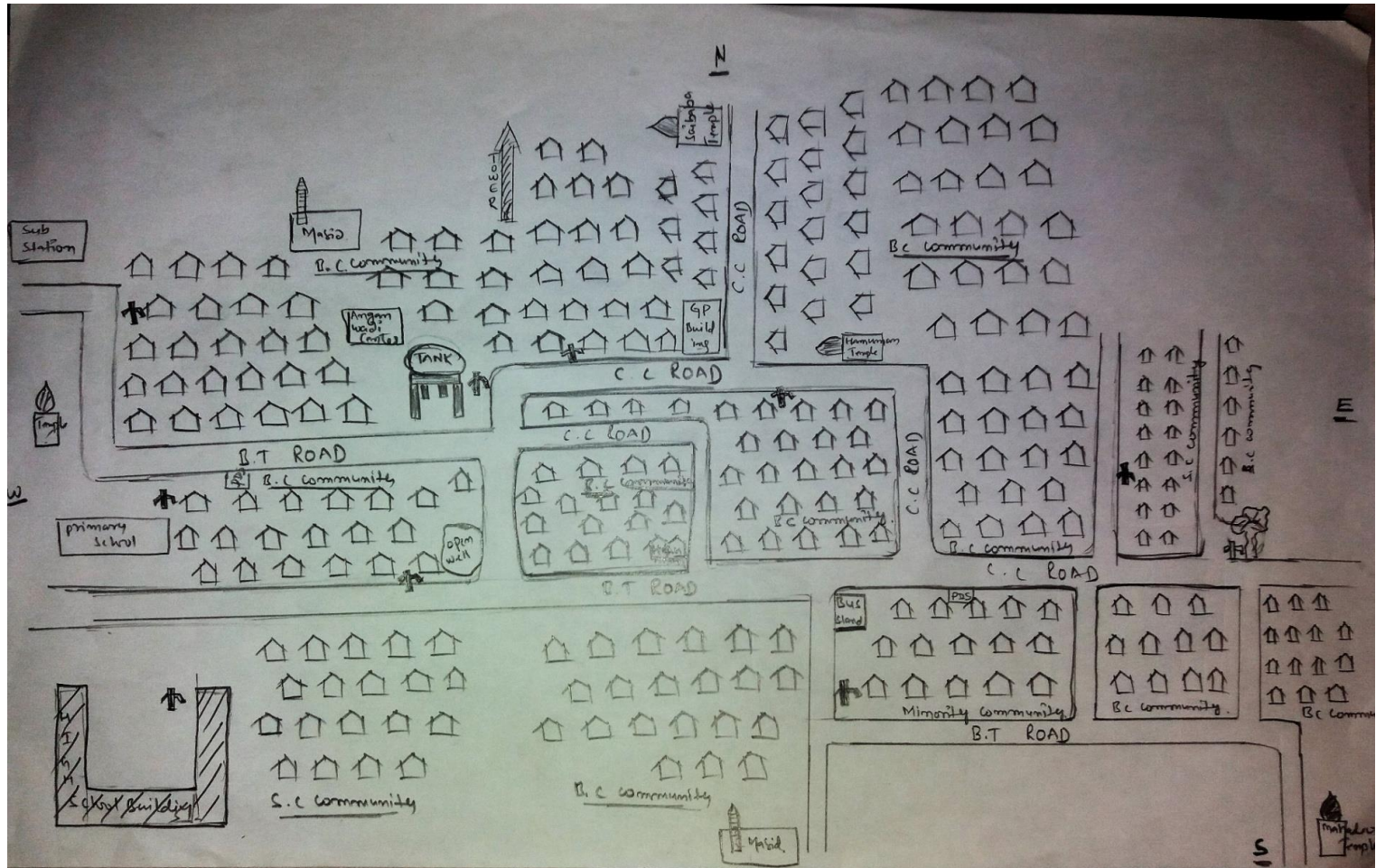


# About the Village Waddur

# Social map of Waddur village

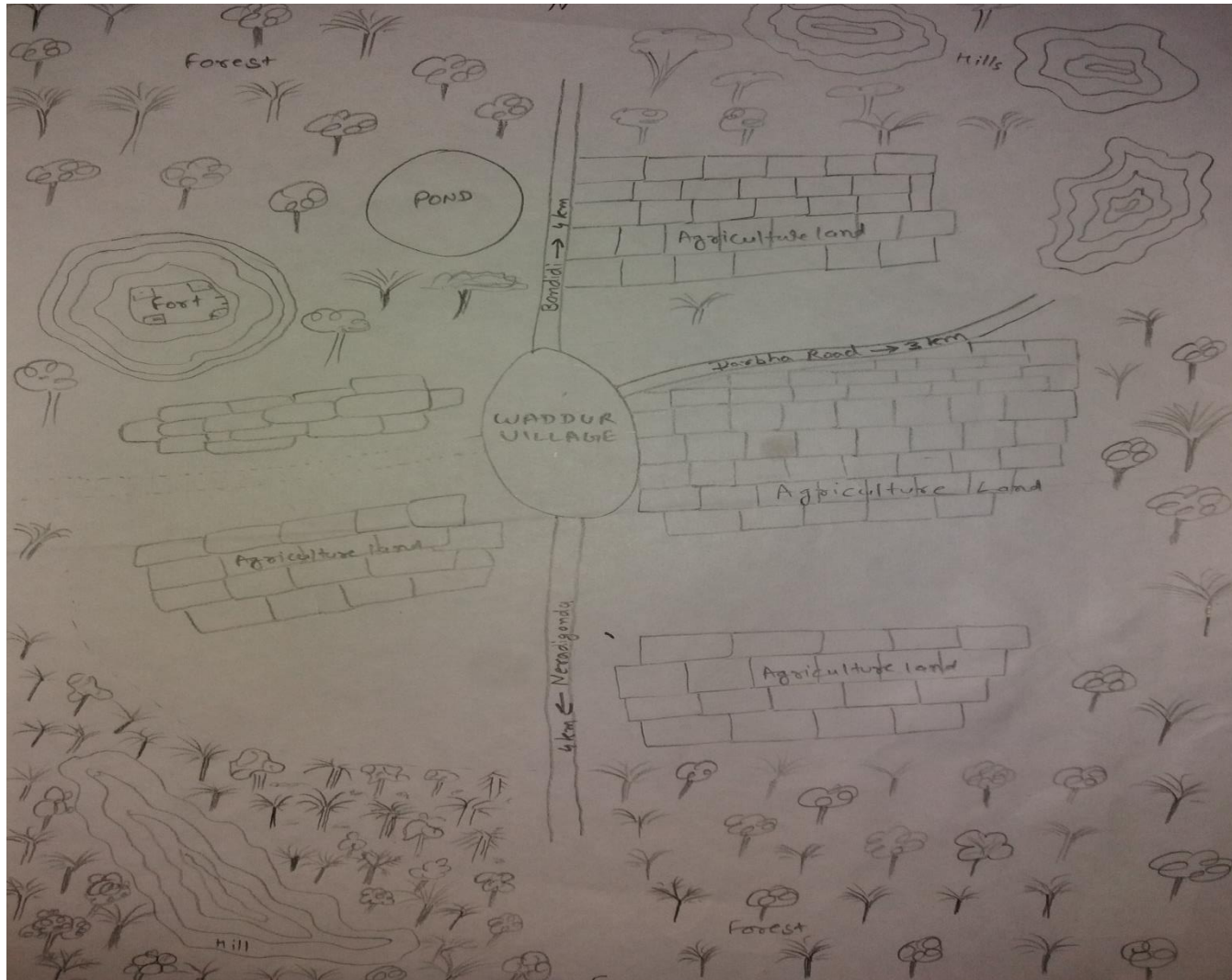

# Connectivity of the village

- Nirmal is the Nearest Town to Waddur. Nirmal is 35 km from Waddur. Road connectivity is there from Nirmal to Waddur.
- The village has its own post office and the pin code of Waddur village is 504323.
- Nearest railway station is Kinwat which is 44.6 km from the village.
- Road connectivity is good. Neradigonda mandal is 4 kms from the village. NH-44 passes through Neradigonda.

# Beedi Making

- Beedi making is a major source of employment for the village women.
- There are total 302 registered beedi workers in the village.
- The raw material is *Kendu Patta* and tobacco leaves that are provided by the beedi company.
- *Kendu patta* is also collected by the villagers from the nearby forests.
- There are 6 companies working nearby the villages.
- Beedi workers handover the final product to these companies which further send the beedi packs to the beedi factory in Neradigonda.
- The beedi made by the villagers are further exported to Gujarat.



# MGNREGA work

- There are total 975 registered job cards under MGNREGA scheme.
- Creation of trenches are for holding and diverting the rain water is going on under the MGNREGA scheme.
- Almost 490 workers are working on all sites in the village.
- wages of Rs. 205 is provided to each labourer. Rs 5 for bringing water daily and Rs. 10 for the maintenance of their tools is also being provided.
- Amount is credited directly to the post office account of the labourers.
- Issues in the payment delivery. For the past 3-4 months the payment is not provided to many workers.

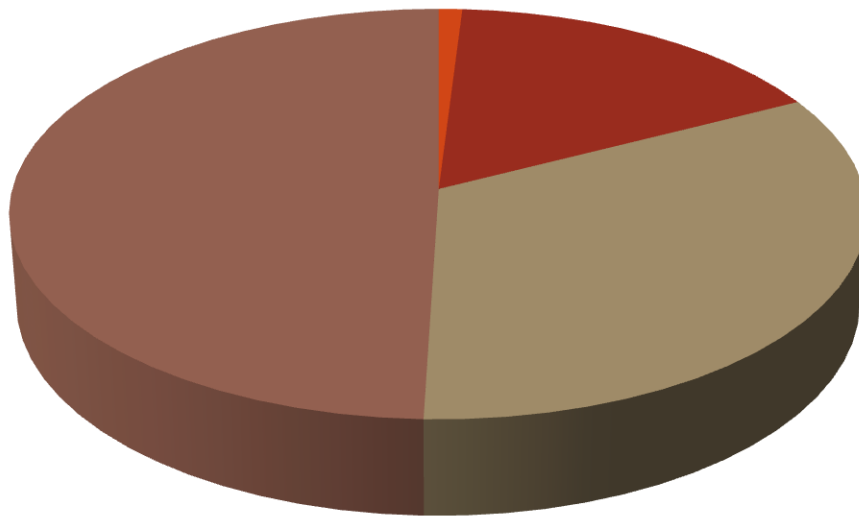


# Agriculture Details :-

- 550-600 households involved in agriculture.
- 300 households having their own land.
- Others are landless labourers.
- Cotton, soya, gram, jwar, wheat, mung dal, arahar, coriander are chiefly grown.
- Seasonal vegetables like brinjal, bitter-guard, tomato, turai
- Around 200 tubewells for the irrigation process.
- Irrigation sources being rainwater and tubewells.
- Ground water level decreases in summer, causing hindrance in irrigation.

■ medium land owners(5-20 acres) 16.67%

■ small land owners (less than 5 acres) 33.34%

■ landless labour 50%

# EDUCATION :-

- Schools play major role in imparting education. There are three schools in the village up to class 10th level:-



1. Primary school:- Class 1 to 5



2. Secondary school:- Class 6 to 10



3. Upper Primary school:- (Urdu medium), class 1 to 7.

- Mid Day Meal Scheme
- Extra curricular activities
- Sports activities
- Library is available in High School
- Computer facilities also available
- projector facilities available in Village High School.
- Free uniform and textbooks
- Lack of sufficient desks and benches for the students.
- Lack of compound wall and girls toilet.



# Aanganbadi in the village

- There are three working anganbadi centers
- Aanganbadi kendra- 1  
Total registered children- 25  
Operational in Upper Primary School
- Aanganbadi kendra- 2  
Total registered children- 18  
Separate building is provided by Panchayat
- Aanganbadi kendra- 3  
Total registered children- 15  
Operational in rented building (not in good condition)



# Health Care

- One Health Sub-Centre in the village.
- One ANM and 2 Asha workers.
- 4 RPM's in the village.
- One Medical shop
- Primary Health Centre is 4 km away in Neradigonda.
- 108 and 102 ambulance service is available from Neradigonda.



# Health Care (cont..)

- Operation theatre at PHC
- Emergency Ward at PHC
- All basic medicines are available
- State Schemes(KCR Kit)
- Referral options:
  1. Nirmal (30km): area hospital and MCH
  2. RIMS Adilabad(50 km)



# Health Care (cont..)

## KCR Kit

- Total pregnant women in the village: 25
- Previous year 52 beneficiaries of KCR kit.
- 12k for boy child and 13k for girl child to be paid in 4 instalments (for first two child)

# Gram Swaraj schemes

## ➤ Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana

- Aims to safeguard the health of women and children by providing them with clean cooking fuel- LPG
- In Waddur village most of the household already have LPG connection
- Many household got the LPG connection through Deepam pathakam scheme of state government.
- Total beneficiary of Ujjwala Yojana in the village: 10
- Almost 550 household out of 654 are having LPG connections.

## ➤ Saubhagya (pradhan mantri sahaj bijli har ghar yojana)

- All households were already electrified before the launch of the scheme.
- A power sub-station of 33/11kv was installed in 2014.
- After the installment of sub-station the village is getting almost 24 hrs electricity everyday.



## ➤ **UJALA Scheme**

- Aims to promote efficient use of energy at the residential level by promoting LED bulbs
- Currently not being implemented in Waddur village.
- Most of the households are using either LED's or CFL.  
All LED street lights in the village.

### ➤ **Pradhan mantri Jan Dhan Yojana**

- Aims at financial inclusion of the people.
- Total 1400 zero balance accounts
- These accounts are used for various subsidies and pension schemes.

### ➤ **Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima**

- Available to people in 18-50 yrs age group.
- Annual premium of Rs.330

### ➤ **Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima**

- Available to people in 18-70 yrs age group.
- Annual premium of Rs. 12

## ➤ **Mission Indradhanush**

- It aims to immunize all children under the age of 2 years, as well as all pregnant women against seven vaccine preventable diseases.
- The vaccines are already covered in KCR Kit and other State health schemes.
- No separate implementation of Mission indradhanush in the mandal.



# State Schemes

## ➤ **Mission Bhagiratha**

- Is a project for safe drinking water for every village and city households
- Pipelines along with optical fibre are being laid



## ➤ Haritha Haram

- 8700 Sagwan plants to 16 Farmers
- 40 Sagwan plants to 2 Schools



# Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

- Waddur is Open defecation free village.
- Still open defecation was observed.
- Overall cleanliness of the village is good.
- Drainage is not well planned.
- Water logging was observed at several places.
- Magic soak pit and normal soak pits were installed at several places.

# Issues

- There is no properly planned drainage system in the village
- Open Soak pits are not cleaned from time to time
- No kitchen shed, compound wall, dual desks and separate toilet for girls in High School
- Open defecation is observed
- Anganwadi centres and Health sub centre are very congested
- Two Mandals share one 108 ambulance



# Suggestions

- Gram Panchayat and district administration need to sensitize villagers against open defecation, to not clog existing drains, soak pits and get them cleaned from time to time
- High School should meet its minimum requirement standards
- Anganwadi and health centre should be moved to a spacious place
