



- Volunteers held early morning and late evening learning sessions with villagers.
- Out of 182 Identified, 100 villagers were certified by NIOS to be literates. Thereby increasing literacy rate further.



Drip Irrigation

- Array of Pipes are spread over the fields near crops line. These pipes have multiple small holes beneath them that allows water to drip slowly to the roots of crops.
- ✓ Efficient water application.
- ✓ Field levelling not necessary.
- ✓ Soil erosion and weed growth lessened.
- Fertilizer and nutrient loss is minimized.
- √ 90% state Government Subsidy

Challenges

- 1. Initial setup is complex and technical.
- 2. Requires high maintenance.

Suggestion:

It gives best results combined with sprinkler irrigation systems on which government should draft a policy.

Problems: At site of MGNREGA work there was No Shelter, Water supply and No First Aid facility too that is against the scheme of MGNREGA.




CURRENTLY 180 PEOPLE ARE WORKING IN MGNREGA

Mini Water Tank





MISSION BHAGIRATHA


- ☐ Project for safe drinking water for every village and city household in Telangana.
- Budget for Nagapur village is 35 lacs.
- 4.22 Km of water and internet cables to be laid. Out of which 3.8 Km cables have been laid underground.
- 100 L water per person to be supplied daily.
- Average rate of water supply is 4.5 person per household for village.
- ☐ As per survey water supply will start in month of June.

Blueprint of water cables to be laid under Bhagiratha Mission




Technical Process for providing Purifying Water under Bhagiratha Mission


KAKATIYA MISSION


- Restoring of all minor irrigation tanks and lakes in the state

PRADHAN MANTRI UJJWALA YOJANA

OBJECTIVE: Provide LPG connections to women from BPL households.

STATUS: The Telangana government has already "Deepam Scheme" working effectively in Nagapur Village that provides LPG connections. Deepam scheme is dependent on Centre for funds. There is Universal coverage of LPG Connection in village.

PRADHAN MANTRI SAHAJ BIJLI GHAR YOJNA (SAUBHAGYA)

Aim: To provide energy access to all by last mile connectivity and electricity connections to all remaining un-electrified households in rural as well as urban areas.

- **Status**: 1. Each house hold in Village already had electric connections sponsored by state government and free meter connections for agricultural purposes.
 - 2. No awareness and knowledge about this scheme in village as not required.



UNNAT JYOTI BY AFFORDABLE LEDS FOR ALL (UJALA)

AIM: To promote efficient lighting, enhance awareness on using efficient equipment which reduce electricity bills.

- 1,65,000 LEDs have been distributed in Nizamabad district
- No awareness among villagers about this scheme. No distribution center nearby.
- The street lights in village are CFL and Tube lights only.

PRADHAN MANTRI JAN DHAN YOJNA

AIM: National Mission for Financial inclusion to ensure access to financial services like banking, loans, insurance, subsidies and Pensions.

STATUS:

- Most of the villagers were having a Bank Account prior to scheme as they use it for pensions, subsidies transfers and loan purposes by SHGs members.
- Universal access to Banking facilities after launch of PMJDY.

INSURANCE COVERAGE SCHEMES

PRADHAN MANTRI JIVAN JYOTI BIMA YOJNA

- * Life Insurance Scheme
- * Premium Rs 330 per annum
- * Amount of Rs 2 lakhs is given in case of death for any reason

PRADHAN MANTRI SURAKSHA BIMA YOJANA

- * Accidental Insurance scheme
- * Premium Rs 12 per annum
- * Risk Coverage is Rs 2 lakh

- No awareness among the villagers about the schemes
- Inbuilt Insurance Schemes like Abhay Gold, Abhay Jeevan and Abhay plus etc with SB Accounts is provided by Andhra Bank.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Provide Bank Customer Service Point or Bank Mitra in the village & participation of Bank officials in Gram Sabha.
- Effective Monitoring of schemes like Haritha Haram, Swatch bharat and others
- Effective supervision of village level institutions like Anganwadi center,
 PDS(Ration shop) by Gram panchayat and mandal level officials
- Library with computer facility in the school.
- Benefits of the UJALA scheme should be brought to the village.
- Replacement of Kerosene oil in PDS with other provisions like Dal, cooking oil etc.
- Setup of public utility services like Public Toilet and operative busstop.
