• Ethics in social fabric- includes family, <u>work place</u> and other social places

Essential Elements at Work (Contd..)

Congenial Atmosphere:

Physical Atmosphere(5 S methods), Emotional Atmosphere(Relations)

Physical Atmosphere: (Follow -5 S methods)

Sorting: Eliminate all unnecessary things. Keep only essentials.

Setting in order(Straightening): Arranging the most frequently used items with easy access.

Sweeping/Shine: Keep the work place clean, tidy and organized.

Standardising: All work places for a particular job shall be identical.

Sustaining the practice: Maintainenance and review of the above parameters.
