Paper Length:	Abstract: 300–500 words Full paper should preferably be between 4,000–6,000 words
Format:	Manuscripts should be submitted in MS Word format (.doc/.docx).
Font & Spacing:	Times New Roman font with 12 pt size for text and 14 pt for headings, maintain 1.25 line spacing, and keep 1-inch margins on all sides.
Plagiarism:	Similarity index should be below 15% (excluding references); AI content limit <15%
Originality:	The paper must be original and unpublished.
Referencing style:	APA format.

Publication Opportunity: Selected papers will be published in the Institute Journal 'Samridhi' a Bi - annual Journal of Dr. MCR HRD Institute.
