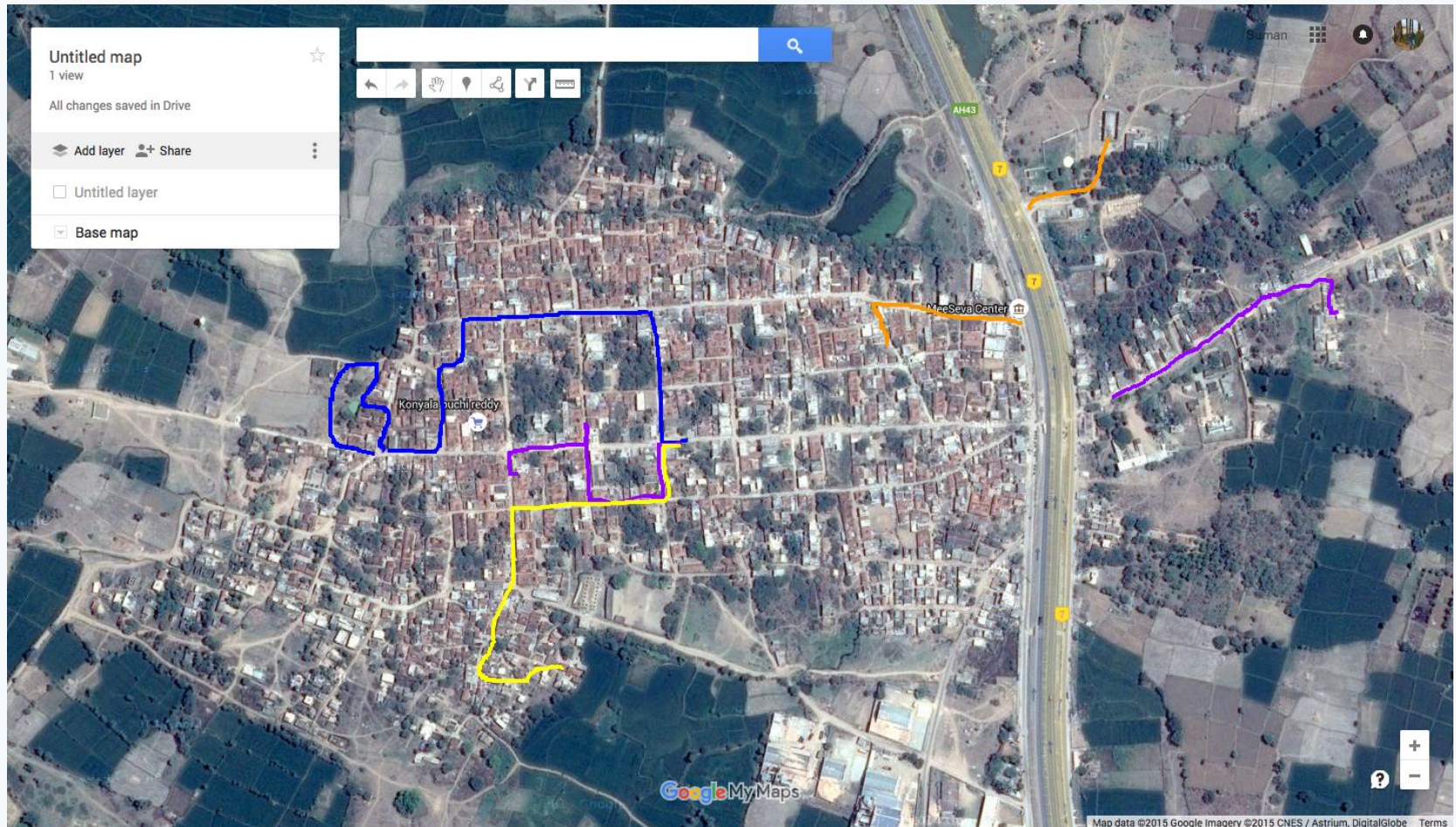

Late 1940s: National Highway - single road

1960s: Primary Health Centre (PHC) established in village

Late 1960s to Mid 1970s: Electrification of village, underground tap water, post office, primary school

1970: State Bank of India (SBI) branch established

1983 to 1990: Village roads constructed

Mid 1990s: Water tank constructed

2000s: Secondary school established

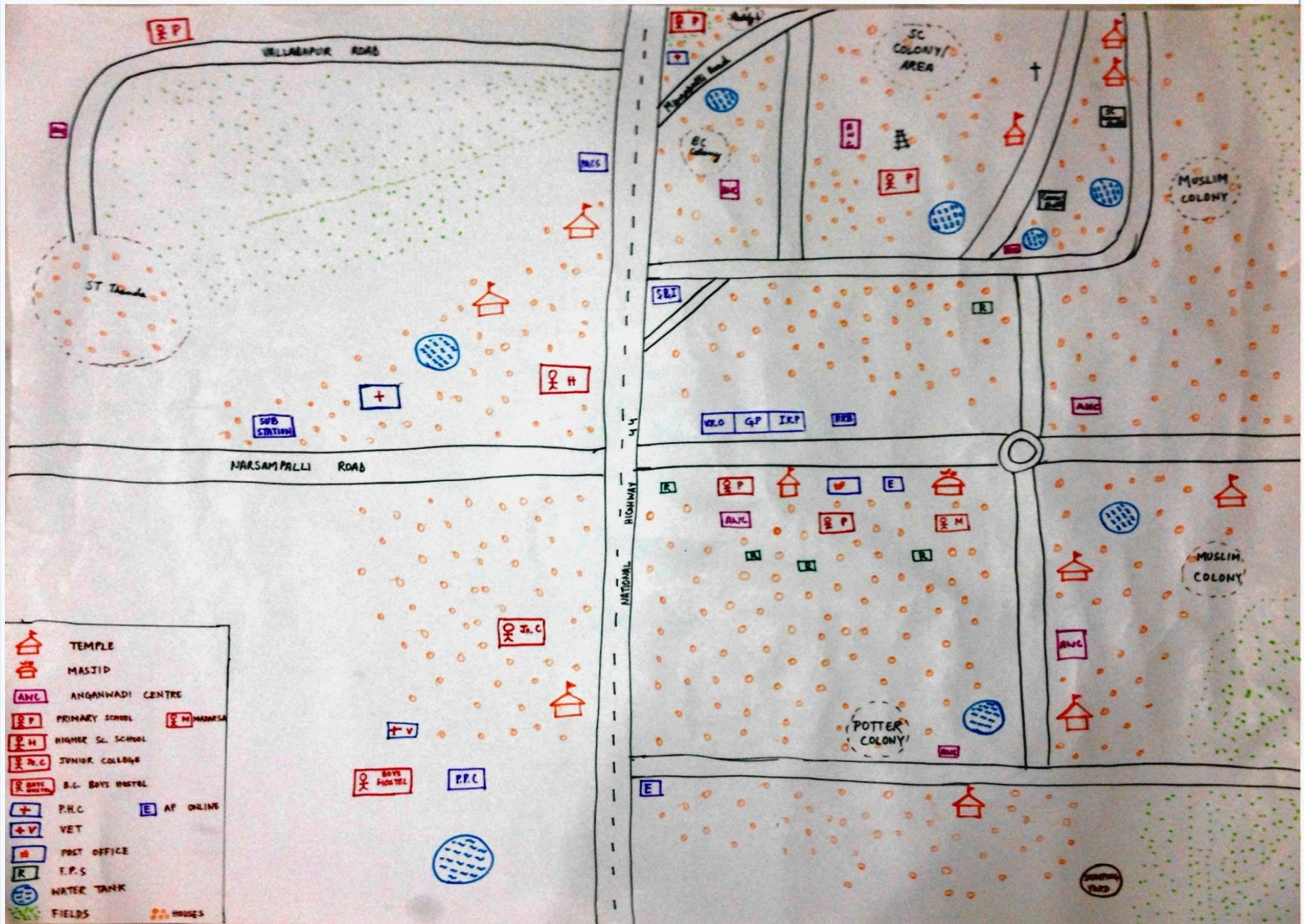
2006 to 2007: Four laning of National Highway

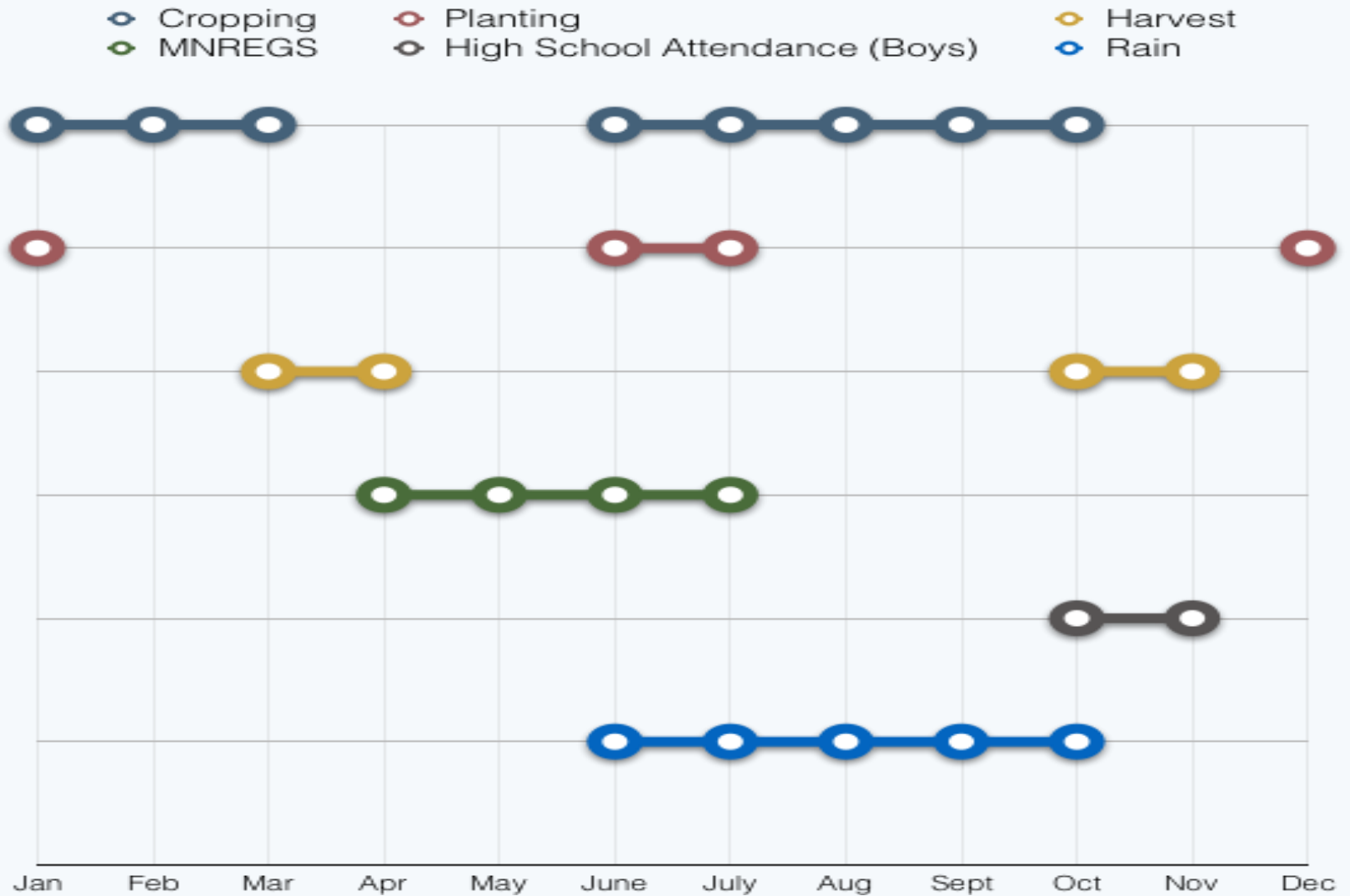

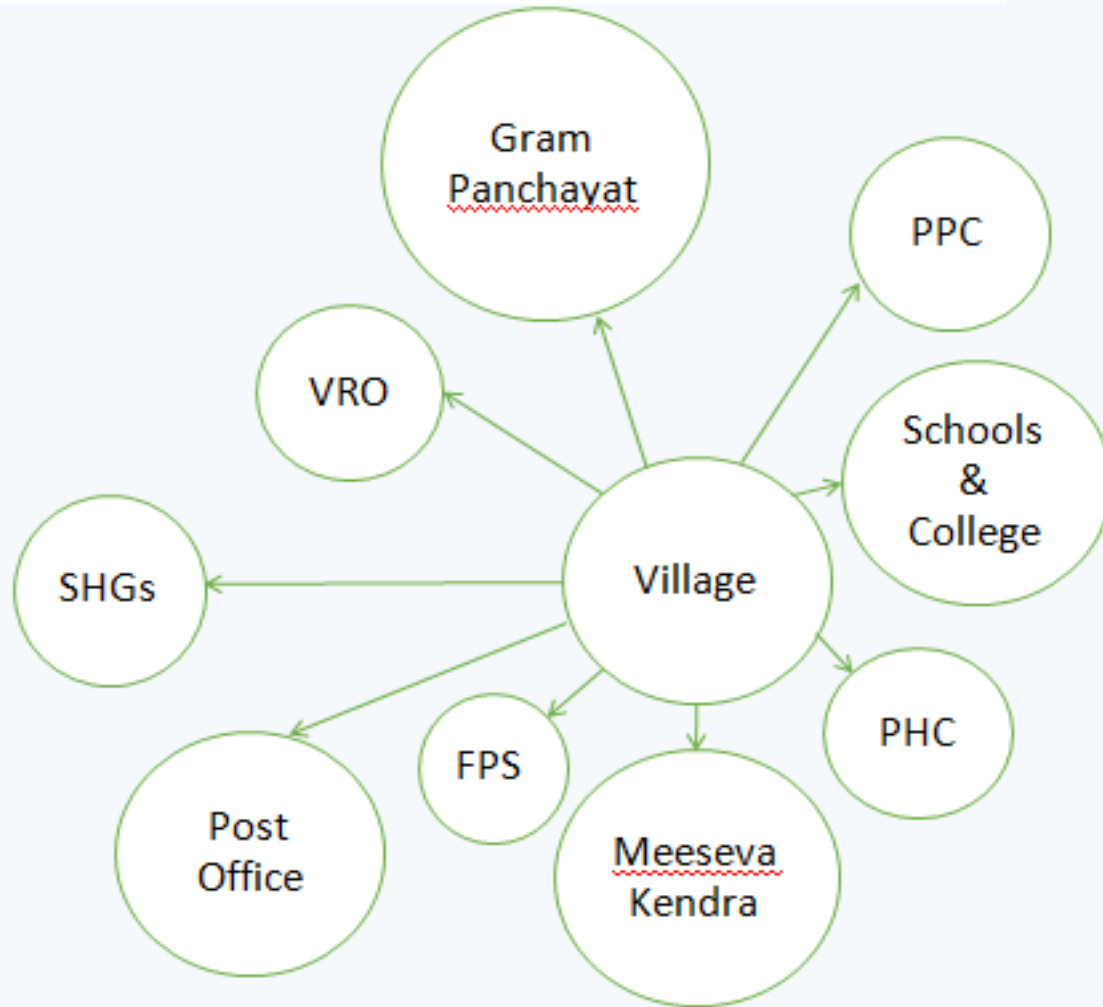

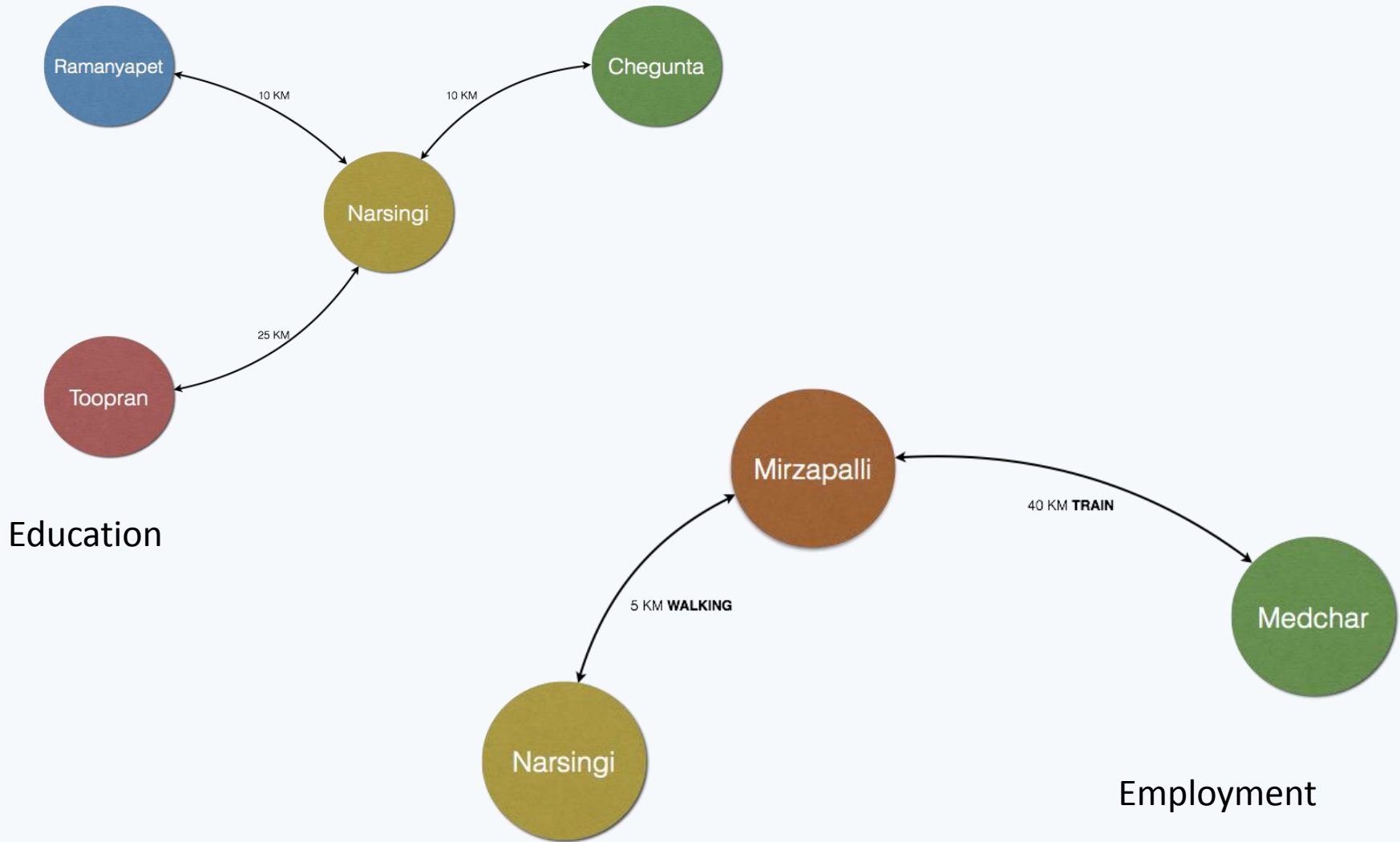
Prioritization matrix (lower score is higher priority)

Livelihood Creation

Occupations : Farming, Cattle Sale, Poultry, Daily wage, Beedi workers, Potters, Forest nursery

Issues : Drought, No work, Low labor wage

A hand-holding department for livelihood generation

- E.g. Forest Department of Dhamtari division in Chattisgarh & Udaipur, Rajasthan
- Vermi Compost & Organic Farming



- Aloe Vera extraction and processing
- Government degraded land projects
 - Eg. Jamun trees with vegetables (Revenue with Forest department coordination)
- Agave ropes



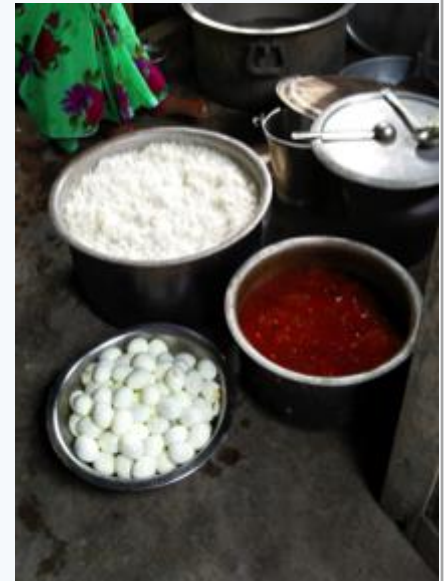
Self Help Groups (SHGs)

- Inter-SHG lending as a pilot
- Handholding agency for SHG
- Capacity building via entrepreneurship (through NGOs or other departments)

- Schools understaffed
- Library, Lab

Important Observations :

- NH44 separates village and hospital
- Surgeon & anesthetist needed for Operation Theatre in PHC – Currently unused
- Sensitization towards sanitation and cleanliness
- Vasectomy v/s tubectomy
- Institutional deliveries

- ✓ Functions
- ✓ Number

Important Observations:

- Malnutrition endemic
- Building but no toilets
- No water supply
- No electricity
- Growth chart register
- Nutrition
- Immunization
- Special need children



Water & Sanitation

Drinking Water

- Underground
- Overhead tanks

Irrigation

- Rainfall, tanks, borewell
- Drip irrigation as a pilot

Sanitation

- Use of toilets not prevalent
- Drains cleaned by digging, dumping yard
- Roads on a higher elevation, difficulty in rainy season.
