

#### **Importance of DPSP**




- Part IV, Art.36-51, Art.335, 351-Directive for Development of Hindi Language etc
- Designed to usher in social and economic democracy
- Non-justiciable but fundamental in governance of the country
- Impose duty on State to apply them in making laws

#### **Philosophy of Directives**



- Welfare state
- Politico-socio-economic democracy
- Contain long term goals of constitution
- Guide exercise of legislative power but do not control it
- Supplementary and complementary to F.Rts.

#### **Philosophy of Directives**



- Not mere pious obligations
- Another name for Instrument of Instructions
- Not absolute
- Subject to economic capacity & development –E.g. Art.41
- Also subject to existence of congenial atmosphere – E.g. Art 44

- Part-IV, Art. 36-51
- 19 Articles in all
- 42<sup>nd</sup> Amendment, 86<sup>th and</sup> 97<sup>th</sup>
  Amendments their impact
- State same meaning as u/a 12
- Also contained at other places in Constitution





- Social and Economic Charter Arts.38 & 39
- Social Security Charter -Art.39-A,41,42,43,45,46,47
- Community welfare Charter Art. 40, 44, 48, 48-A, 49, 50 & 51

## An Audit of DPSP & their implementation



- Land reforms, equal pay for equal work, maternity relief, social security
- Free legal aid, local self government
- Right to education and right to Early childhood care and Education for all children up to 06 years
- Environmental protection
- Contentious areas-Uniform Civil Code

#### **DPSP** and Judicial Response



- No hands-off attitude
- Interpretation of many DPSP as F.Rts.
- Directions to enact UCC
- Declaration that Harmony is needed between F.Rts., and DPSP-Art.31-C

#### Conclusion



- DPSP-not intended to remain DPSP forever
- Many laws and programs introduced by State to enforce them
- Remain as conscience of government
- Success of any government-determined in terms of enforcement of DPSP

### Fundamental Duties Art.51-A & Part.IV-A



- Source Soviet and other Socialist Constitutions
- Introduced by 42<sup>nd</sup> Amendment,1976
- 11 in number
- Imposed on citizens
- Statutory duties and enforceable by law
- Aid in interpretation of constitution
