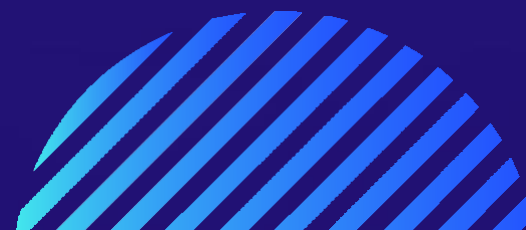


CYBERSECURITY FOOTPRINT IN TELANGANA



Telangana – IT/ITES

Hyderabad is named the global centre of information technology. Not only cybersecurity service companies but also various GCCs and MNCs like Microsoft, Google, IBM, Deloitte have a footprint in the State of Telangana.

To facilitate greater IT and ITeS investments in India, the Telangana government is aggressively establishing Export Oriented Units (EOU), Software Technology Parks (STP), and Special Economic Zones (SEZ).

There are **1500 IT/ITeS companies** that employ over **5.8 lakh professionals**, besides providing indirect employment to over 7 lakh people.

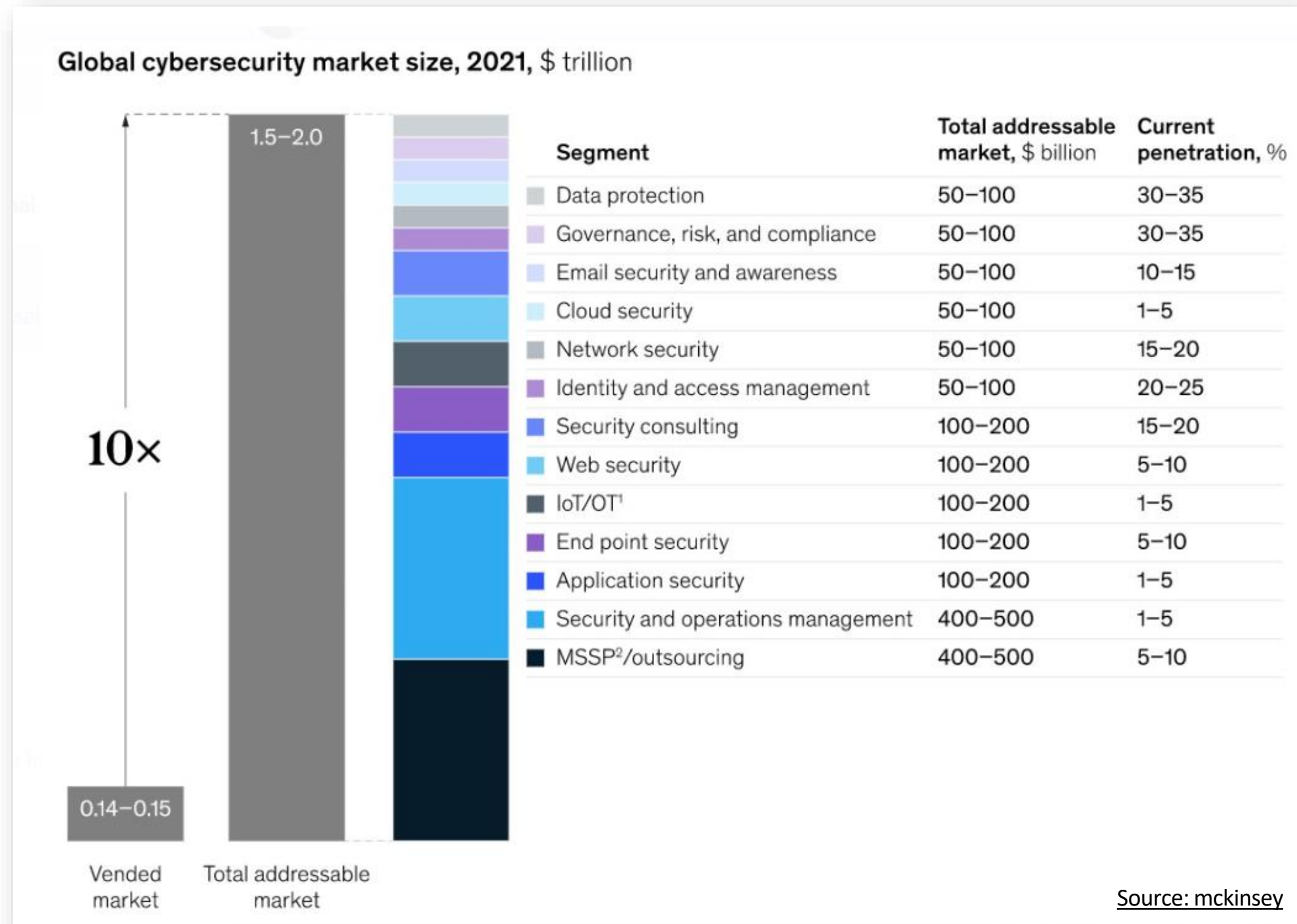
Telangana's **IT/ITeS Exports grew at 17.93%** compared to the **National Average of 8.09%** and the rest of the **Nation's Average of 6.92%**.

Telangana's exports in India went up from **10.6% to 11.6%** and the **share of Telangana** in this year's growth in **National Exports** is a remarkable **23.5%**.

\$2 trillion market opportunity

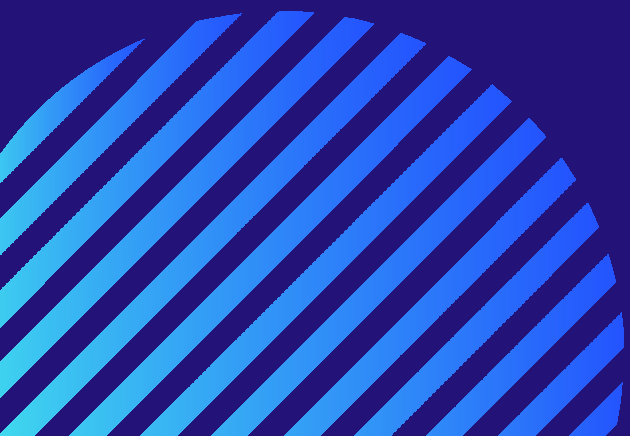
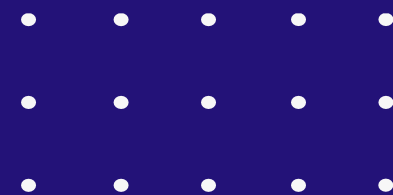
For Cybersecurity Technology And Service Providers

- At the current rate of growth, damage from cyberattacks will amount to about \$10.5 trillion annually by 2025—a 300 percent increase from 2015 levels
- At approximately 10 percent penetration of security solutions today, the total opportunity amounts to a staggering \$1.5 trillion to \$2.0 trillion addressable market



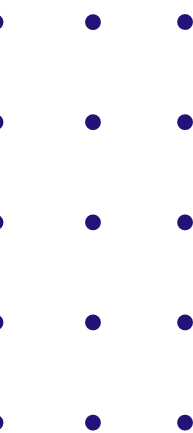
Cybersecurity Market

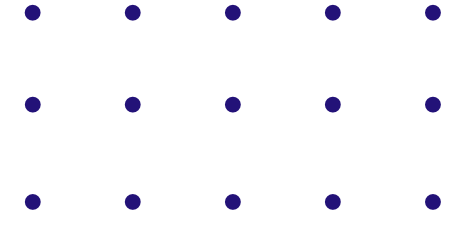
- The **Indian Cyber Security Market** was valued at **USD2200.23 million** in the year **FY2021**.
- The market growth is anticipated to continue during the forecast period, **FY2023-FY2027**, with a **CAGR of 8.05%** to achieve a market value of **USD3543.37 million** by **FY2027**.
- Evolving trend of bringing your own devices (BYOD) to work and thus surging demand to protect the data from the companies and increasing requirement to monitor the sharing of valuable company integral data through BYOD devices are further substantiating the growth of the Indian Cyber Security Market in the forecast years through FY2027.



Demand For Cybersecurity Professionals

- 4,765 job openings were identified in Telangana in FY 2020-2021.
- There were additional 1,107 openings for Security Product companies.
- IT Services/BPM leads in the consumption of cybersecurity skills, reflecting the rising export of cybersecurity services & an increase in domestic demand.
- Global Capability Centres (GCCs) follow the IT Services/BPM with 19% share and the User industry with 14% share according to FY 2020-2021.

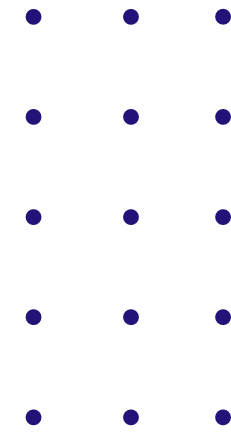

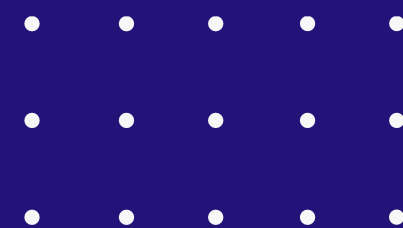

Here, the companies' data and their classification has been done based on the jobs available in the market pertaining to different sectors and domains in cybersecurity.

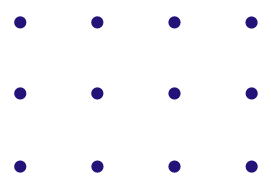
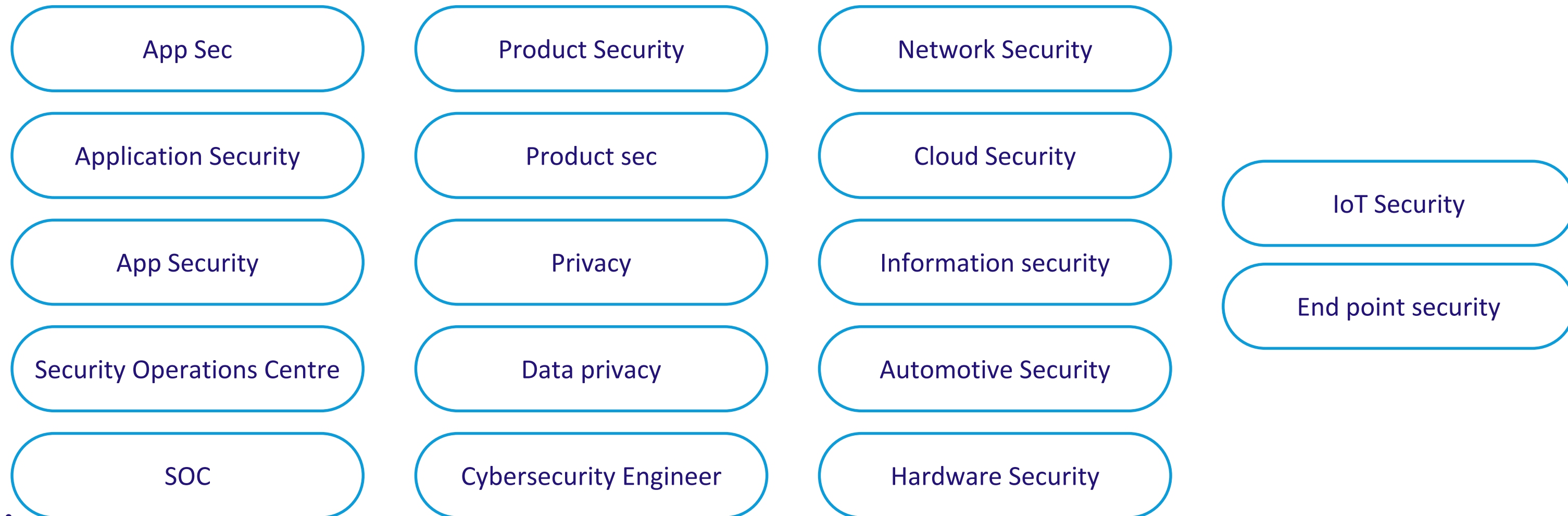
Hence, the number of large companies having cybersecurity teams is greater than the number of small and medium-sized companies in the size-wise demarcation of companies.

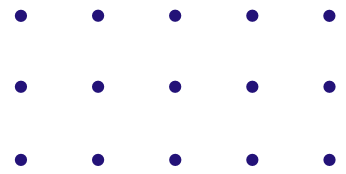
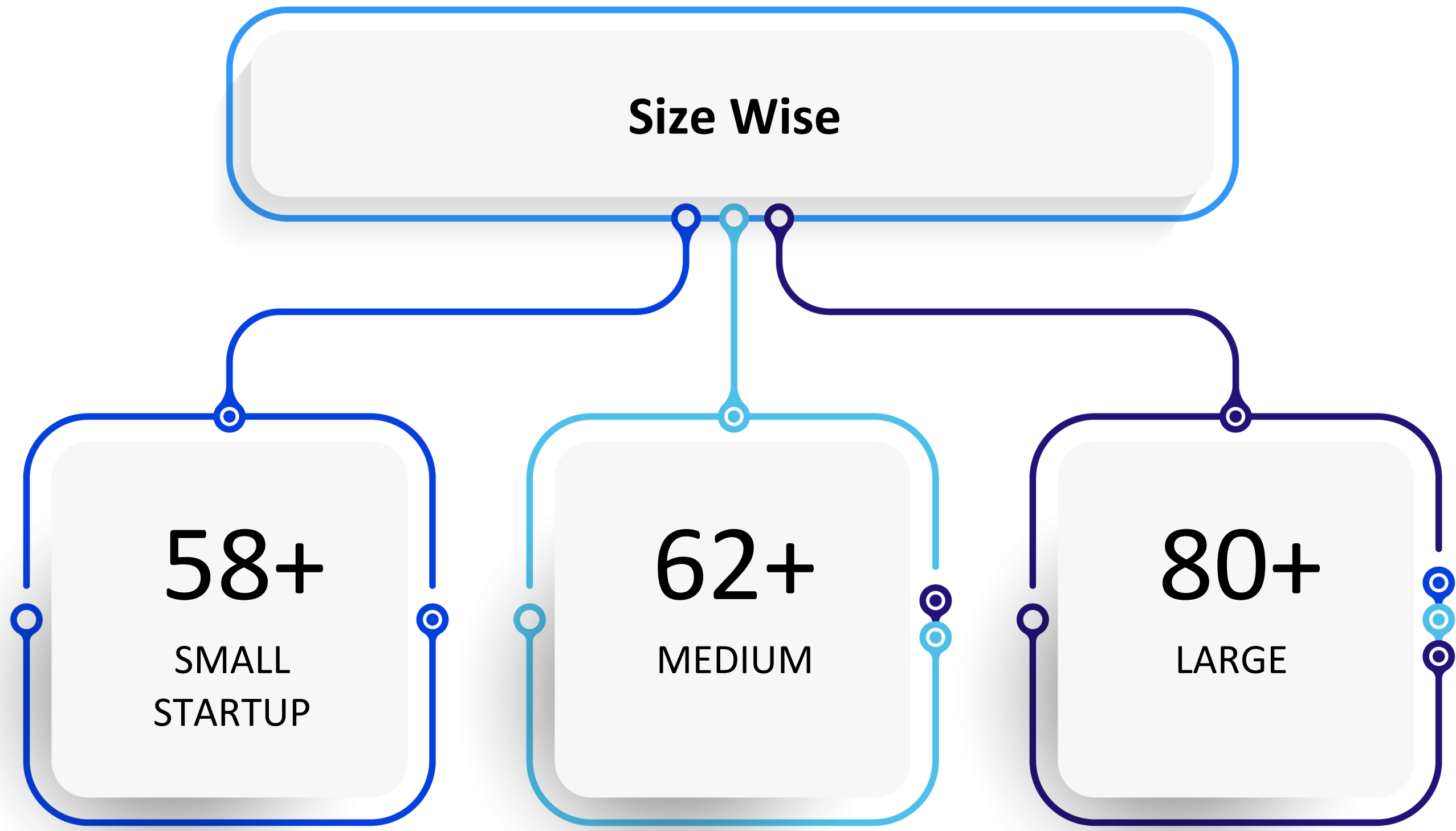
A reason could be that the limitations in budget and staffing lead smaller companies to outsource their cybersecurity work to larger companies.

Accelerator Program with Tech Mahindra

CCoE Startup Showcase Series

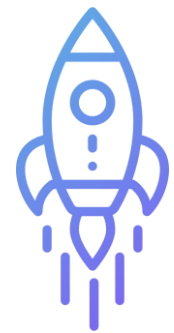
