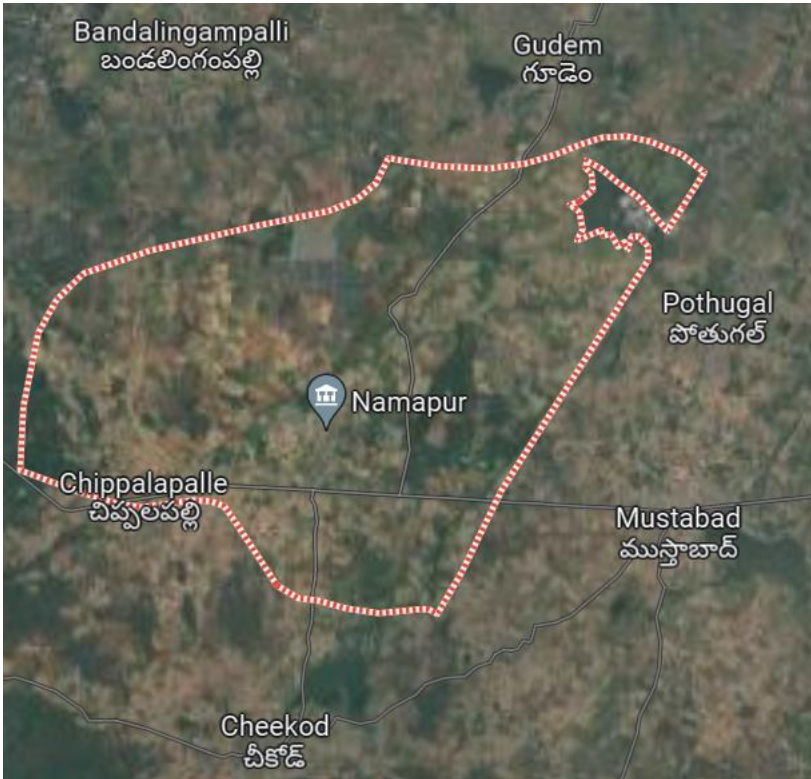

# SHGs

# Basic Health Infrastructure

- No Community/Primary Health Centre.
- One Health Sub Centre which is in Panchayat office.
- 4 Anganwadi Centres in the village.
- Emergency Ambulance facility available
- 4 Asha workers and 1 ANM are working in the village.
- 3 private clinics in the village. Only for basic medical need.
- Vaccinations provided are penta vaccine, measles/rubella vaccine, DPT vaccine.

# Venn Diagram

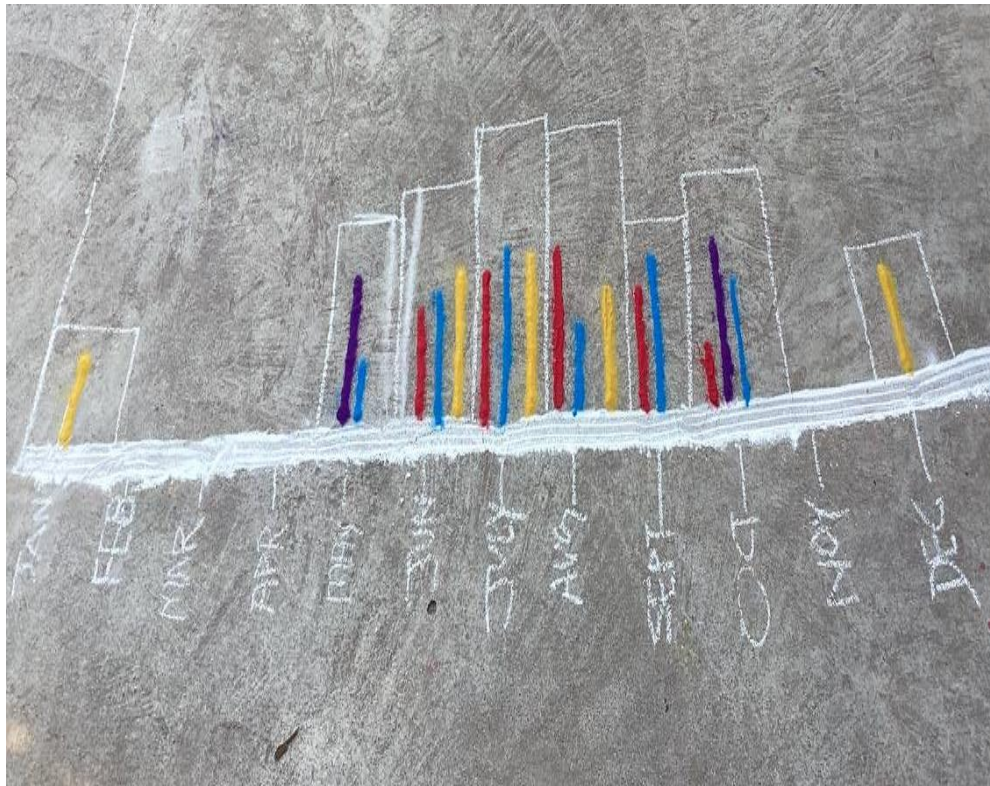
- Shows closeness of institutions which are important to villagers.
