


Profile of Nagaram Village




Seasonal Calendar

Seasonal variations in climatic conditions impinge on crops grown, availability of food grains, fuel, fodder, disease burden etc.



4. Fish Rearing

Government is promoting fish rearing in the village by providing financial assistance for fish production and processing which is in line with government's aim to double the framer's income.

> One private fishpond and one community fishpond

5. Sheep Rearing Scheme

To strengthen the rural economy through the empowerment of Gola and Kuruma communities the Government of Telangana has launched the Telangana sheep rearing scheme.

Under this scheme, the 1.75 lacs per unit has been provided as financial support to shepherds for sheep rearing.

Beneficiaries : Yadav Community

6. Rythu Vedika:

- To help in mobilizing the farmers to organize themselves into groups for attaining their ultimate objective of getting remunerative prices, better marketing facilities, higher productivity and ultimately making agriculture profitable.
- The platforms help farmers meet frequently to discuss their problems and materialize their plans.
- The Rythu Vedica has been established in 2022
- Awareness among the farmers agriculture activity
- The AEO regularly comes to the Rythu Vedica building in the village and conducts meetings with the farmers to discuss various issues related to agriculture.





Mission Kakataiya

Flagship program launched by the government of Telangana in 2014 to rejuvenate and restore the water bodies in the state

Successfully implemented in Nagaram village

> Three water bodies identified, two successfully restored and rejuvenated.

Led to increase in groundwater level, improved agricultural productivity and additional benefits for the villagers





To further reduce land disputes and fraud.	Each land parcel may be assigned a unique number, i.e., Unique Land Parcel Identification Number (ULPIN)
Land records are currently available only in Telugu	Artificial intelligence and deep learning technologies to translate land records into multiple languages.
Rythu Bandhu scheme is currently implemented for land owners only	Policy interventions to support the cultivators instead of landowners which will enhance their motivation and productivity.
Only paddy and cotton are grown	Officials should provide training, guidance, and market access for new crops to support farmers' livelihoods and village development.
Huge dependency on agriculture	A planned poultry farm and dairy farm may be established for generating employment as well as new sources of income and empowering women.



Slow flow of water from newly built taps under Mission Bhagirathi leading to people still using old taps	Planning and awareness regarding filtered water supply under Mission Bhagirathi Scheme.
Grievance Redressal can be prompt and effective	MPDO may take proactive measures by requesting weekly reports from the panchayat secretary on the status of grievances.
No sitting arrangements in the park	Install seating arrangements, gather feedback from villagers, and promote community engagement.

Self Help Groups

- Formed by a group of people who share similar socioeconomic backgrounds and interests
- Women are pro-active in many manners
- There are 28 self help groups in the village consisting of around 10 members each
- Half of the women population is involved in some employment
- Millet biscuits production unit beside Gram Panchayat
- Challenge: Default rate is 20%


