---

- Suryapet district is located in the Indian state of Telangana, carved out of Nalgonda district on October 11, 2016.
- The district headquarters is located in Suryapet town.
- The Government of India announced Suryapet to be developed under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) scheme.
- Suryapet has been awarded the "Cleanest city" in South India by the Ministry of Urban development in Swachh Survekshan 2017.

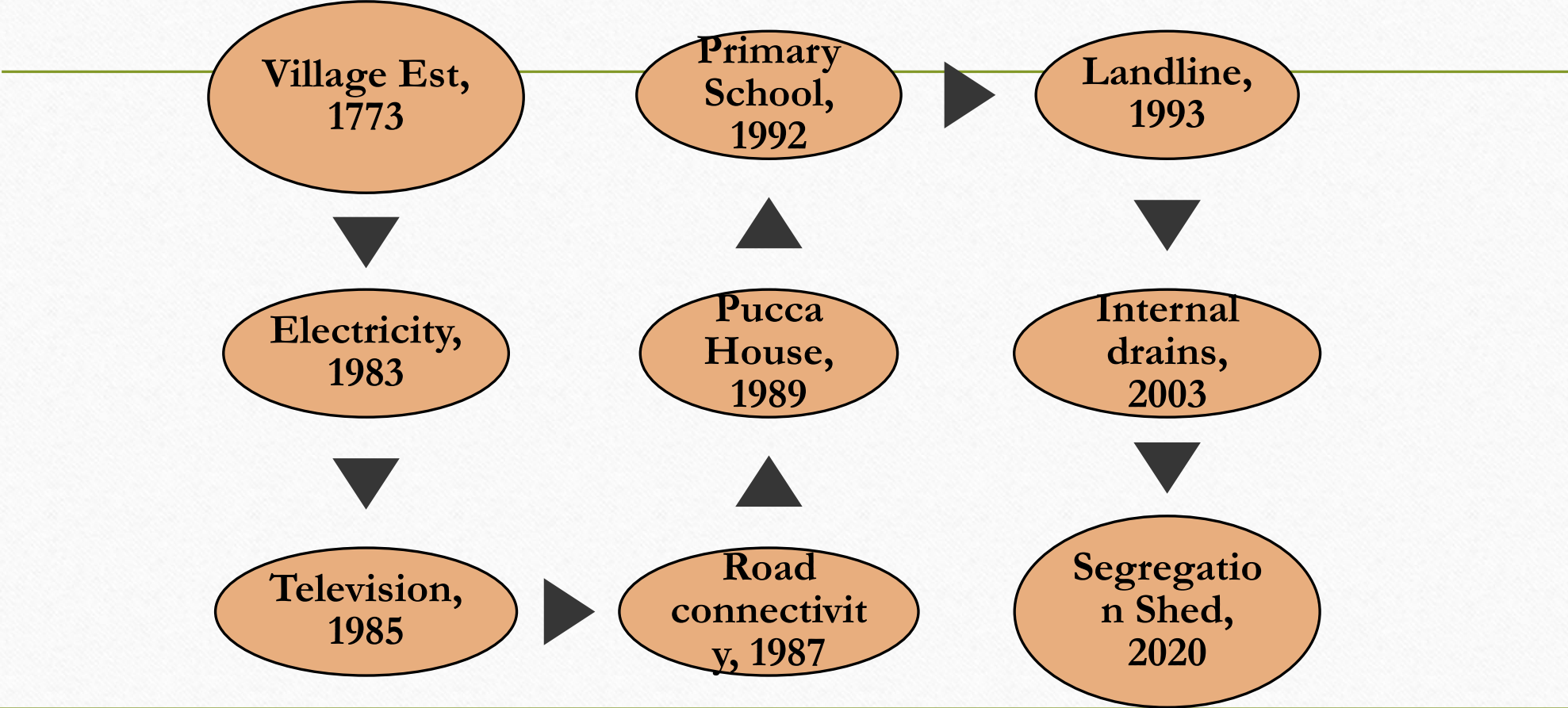
# KUDALI VILLAGE

- The word Kudali means 'Sangam' because of the intersection of two seasonal rivers Peddayeru & Chinnyeru.



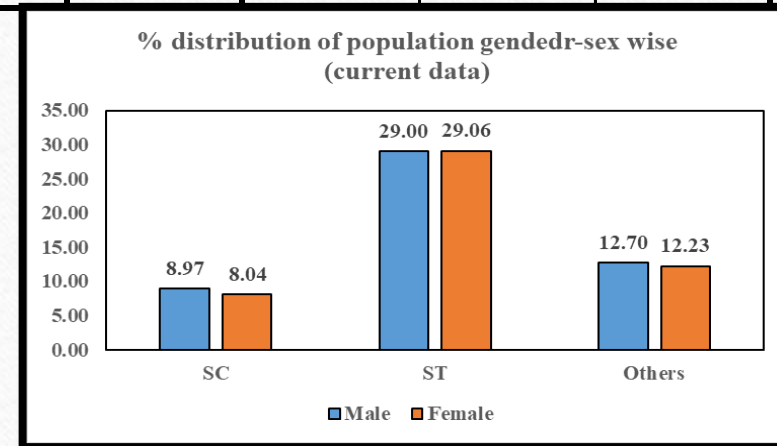
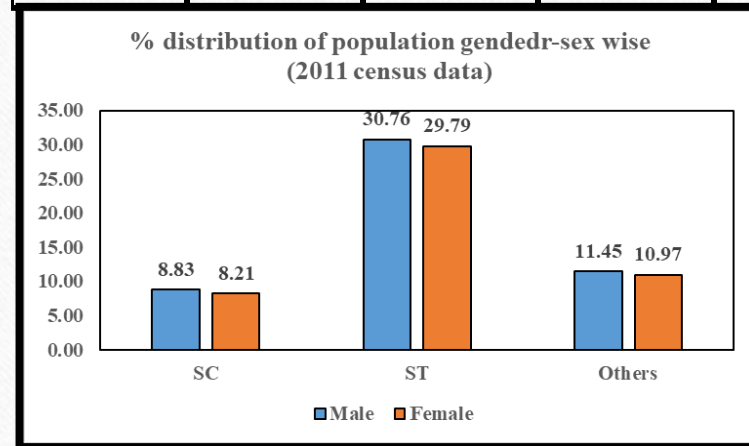

# FARMER'S WELFARE SCHEMES

---

## RYTHU BANDHU

- Eligibility: farmer should own a farm
- 5000 Rs per acre per season

### Way ahead

- Include landless farmers

## RYTHU BIMA

- Eligibility: insurance for farmers (18-59) of Rs 5 lakhs per family
- 100% coverage in village

### Way ahead

- Eligibility > 59 years

## RYTHU VEDIKA

- Cluster of 6-7 village meet
- Agenda: soil testing, availability of pesticides, crop procurement and selling of crops

# IRRIGATION FACILITY

- Irrigation techniques: drip irrigation, canals, check damn, open wells and tube wells.
- 3 ponds with size of 5, 10 and 37 acres respectively.

# MISSION KAKATIYA

---

- A tank restoration and rejuvenation program.
- A 9.5-acre tank is constructed in the village.
- For the desilting process of the tank constructed, under Amrit Sarovar Mission, MGNREGA

- In the village there are two ASHA workers and one ANM.
- Success Story: No cases stunting, wasting and underweight children.
- No death case of mother and child during child birth.

## **KCR KIT (during pregnancy)**

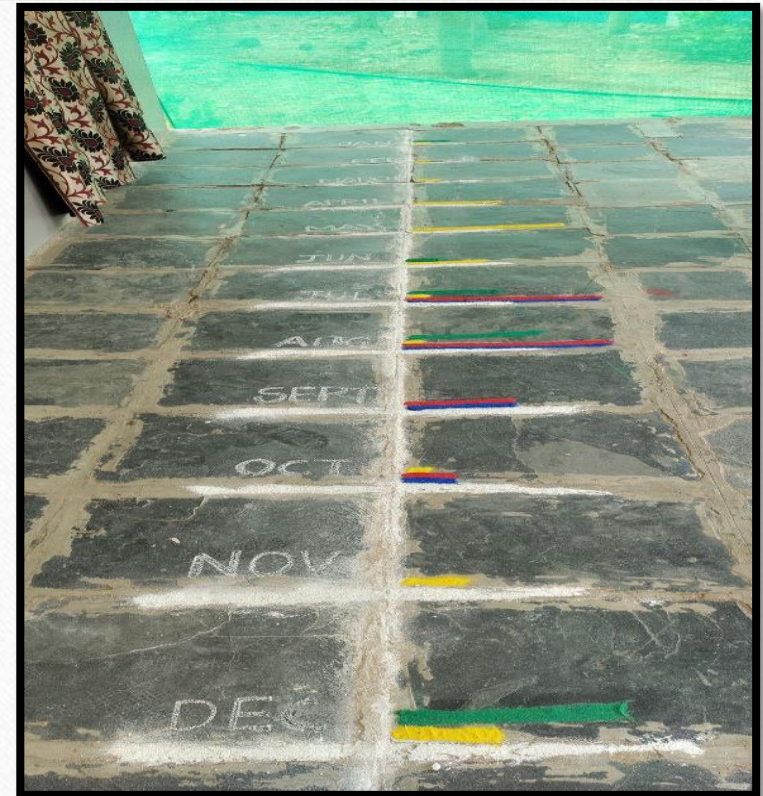
- An aid of ₹3000 is provided for first two babies.
- After the birth of the girl child ₹5000 is provided and ₹4000 in case of a boy, additionally ₹5000 is provided for the immunization and vaccination of the child.

## **MISSION BHAGIRATHA**

- Objective is to provide safe drinking water to every households.
- A 45 Km long pipeline is constructed.
- Village has 2 functional OHSR.

- Regular check ups of height and weight for stunting, wasting and malnutrition under Poshan tracker.





# EDUCATION

- One primary level school with 71 students.
- This village is model village for MOMV.
- Scholarships (Rs. 1500) are provided to students belonging to SC and ST.

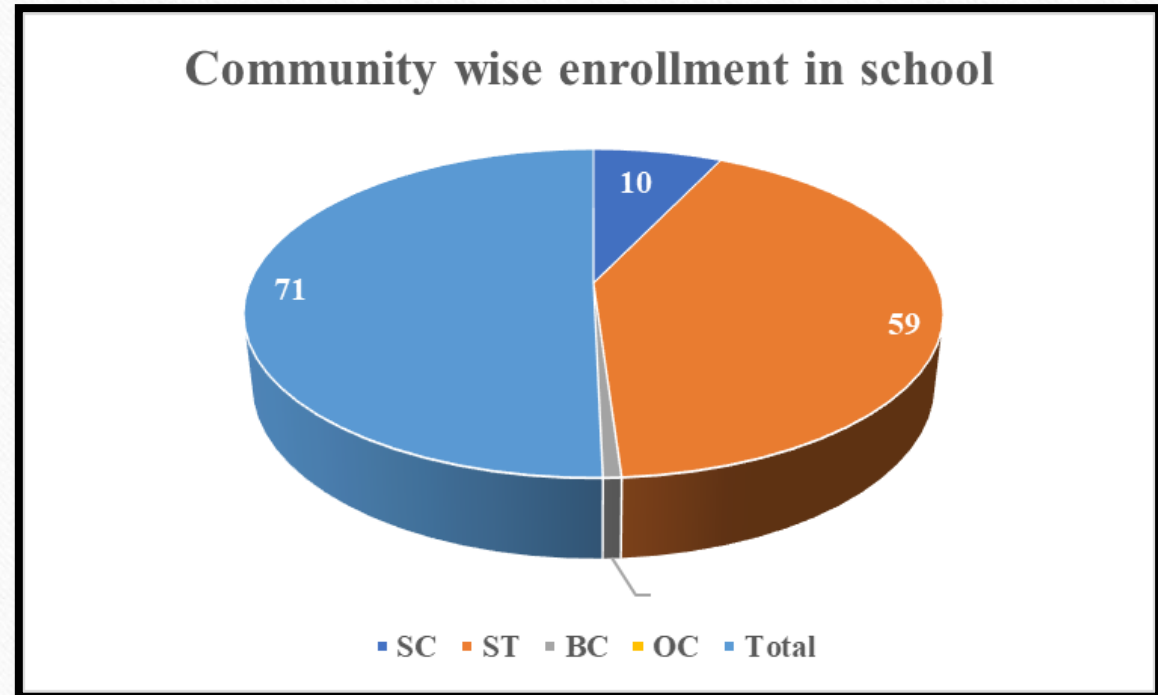

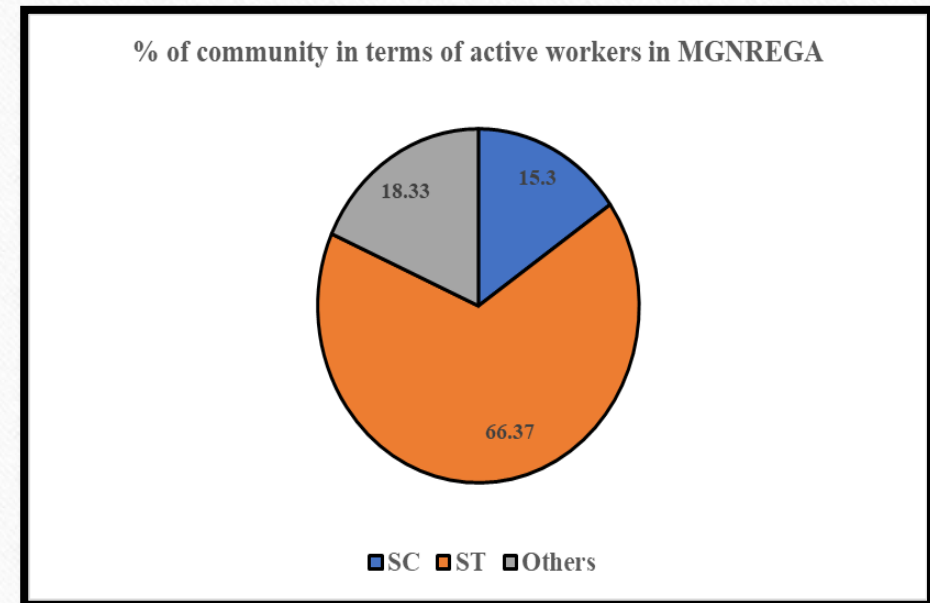
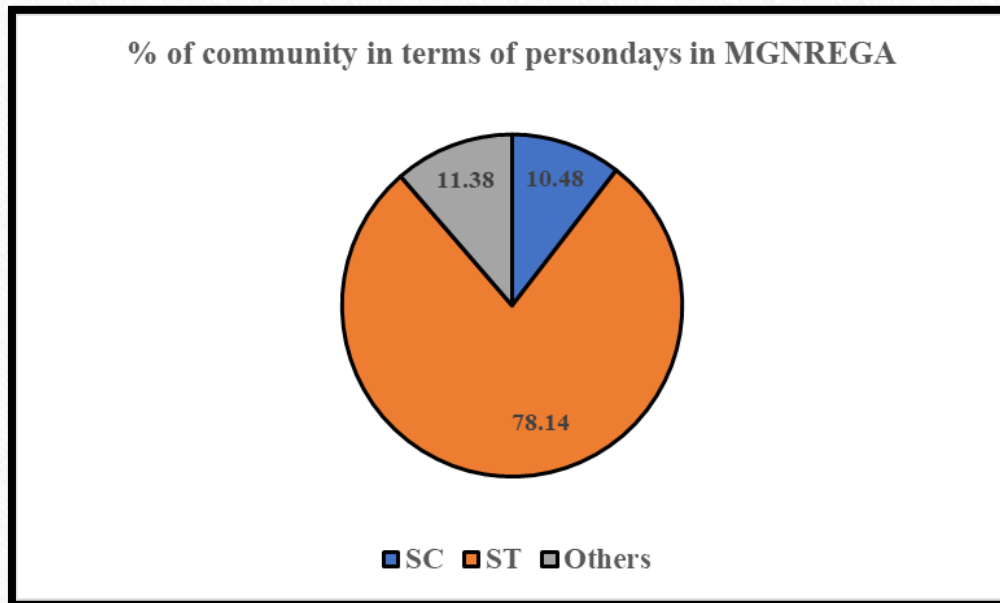

# TELANGANA HARITHA HARAM AND PPV SCHEMES

- Under Haritha Haram scheme each household should plant six plants each year provided by panchayat and each village should have its own nursery.
- Under Pale Pragathi Vanam (PPV) scheme every village should have one artificial developed forest.





# VAIKUNTHA DHAMAM

- Cremation ground (Vaikunta Dhamam) was constructed 2 years ago.
- It has a capacity to cremate two bodies at a time and have a waiting area along with the washrooms.

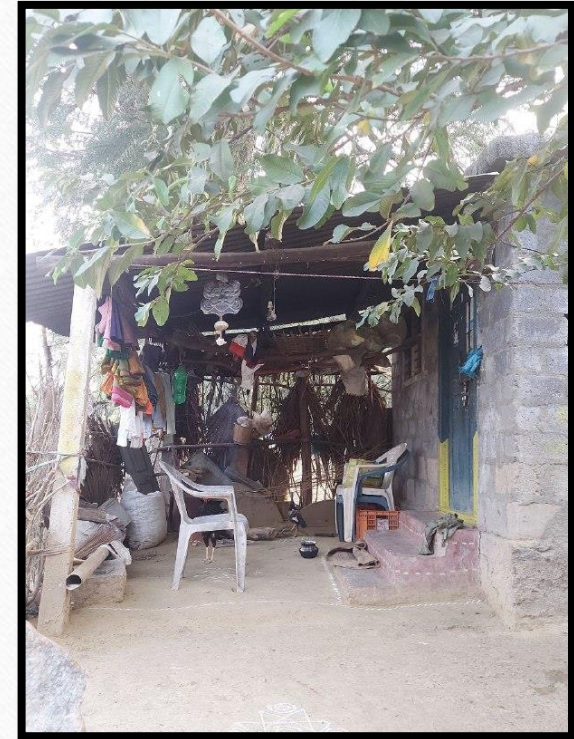




# POVERTY AND UNEMPLOYMENT
